In addition to the recruitment and selection of 39 tenure-track faculty hires for fall 2023, efforts are underway for five leadership positions in Academic Affairs. The positions, all of which have been posted, and a brief overview of the committee's status are noted below.

Associate Vice President/Administrator in Charge of the Palm Desert Campus: This committee, chaired by Rebecca Lubas, dean of University Libraries, had its first meeting on March 26. Six semi-finalists have since been determined and will be interviewed via Zoom during the week of April 10. On-campus interviews for the finalist are expected to occur in late April or early May.

Associate Provost and Dean, College of Extended and Global Education: This committee will kick off this semester and continue into fall 2023. A search firm has been obtained to assist with the process. Following the committee's first meeting, the position posting may be revised.

Selected candidates for these positions, except for the AVP/Dean for the College of Extended and Global Education, are expected to be determined by the end of the semester. A campus email will be sent once finalist and open forum dates are determined.
