

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6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE

POINTS

Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - **Inspector Comments:** Observed that one of the hand wash sinks in front area of "sub connection" had been converted to other use. Since it is the only hand wash sink in the front area (to access closest other sink requires going through swinging door), it must be converted back to a hand wash sink.

Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114155, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

Inspector Comments: Observed several unchained CO2 containers. One was being used as a door prop. Secure all CO2 containers so that they are not a potential safety hazard.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4)Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN

POINTS

Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC -114143 (d), 114266 **Inspector Comments:** Observed debris and grime under and behind large ice machine. Clean and maintain this area.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

IMPORTANT: Risk Based Inspection Frequency

Food facilities that pose a higher risk level for causing foodborne illness will be subject to an additional inspection, to be billed at the hourly rate as provided in the San Bernardino County Code Schedule of Fees. Facilities that received one or more of the following will be elevated to a high risk tier:

- A score letter of "C" or lower on one of the last graded inspections,
- A score letter of "B" on two of the last three graded inspections,
- · Repeated "four (4) point violation Risk Factor" (critical violation codes 1-23) on the last two inspections, or
- More than three (3) critical violations (codes 1-23) noted during an inspection.
