**Attempted Kidnapping**

**Details:**

On March 8, 2015 at approximately 3:05 p.m. a(n) Attempted Kidnapping occurred on the campus of California State University San Bernardino.

This crime occurred at North side of the Pfau Library.

The victim of the crime was a student of the University.

**Suspect/s and/or Vehicle/s Information:**

This afternoon at approximately 3:05 pm, University Police received a report from a student of an attempted kidnapping on the North portion, outside of the Pfau Library. The suspect placed his right hand over the victims mouth and forcibly squeezed her mouth shut and told her "Come on let's go for a ride in my car". The victim in fear for her safety elbowed the suspect to the left side of his body in attempt to escape from his grasp. The suspect immediately released the victim and ran northbound passed the temporary classroom building out of sight.

At this time, the suspect has not been identified and it is not known if he is a member of the campus community. The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, in his 20's, 5'-8", thin build, and medium length dark colored hair. He was wearing dark color shorts and a gray t-shirt. There are no further details at this time.
