SEXUAL BATTERY

Details:

Today, the University Police Department (UPD) was notified of a crime that occurred last week, on Thursday, March 9th around 9:50pm. A female CSUSB student reported she was sexually assaulted by an unknown male, who grabbed her from behind, reached underneath her shirt and touched her breasts. The victim freed herself from the suspect's grasp and fled. The victim subsequently reported the incident to University officials. Based on the limited information, the crime was believed to have occurred on the campus, in the area between the Commons and the Sierra Village housing area.
