TIMELY WARNING NOTICE

(Assault with a Deadly Weapon)

Date: June 12, 2017

Time: 6:20 pm

Details:

On Monday, June 12, 2017, at about 4:41 pm, a student returned to his vehicle, parked in the B-Lot Annex and found a Hispanic male stealing items from his vehicle. The victim confronted the suspect, who entered into a black Honda Accord, driven by a Hispanic female. The suspects attempted to drive away. The victim placed himself in front of the vehicle and was struck by the suspects' vehicle at slow speeds. The victim sustained no injuries during the incident. The suspects were last seen travelling east on North Park Avenue.

Suspect Vehicle:

- The suspects' vehicle is described as a black 1990's model Honda Accord, having window tint.

Suspect #1:

- Hispanic Male, 5'9", described to be in his late 20's – early 30's, thin build, short brown hair, dark pants, grey shirt and wearing sunglasses

Suspect #2:

- Hispanic female, described to be in her late 20's – early 30's, blonde hair, light complexion - no further description.

The suspects are believed to have fled the area, but it is important to remember, if you come across a crime in progress to dial 911 immediately and not place yourself in a hazardous situation.
