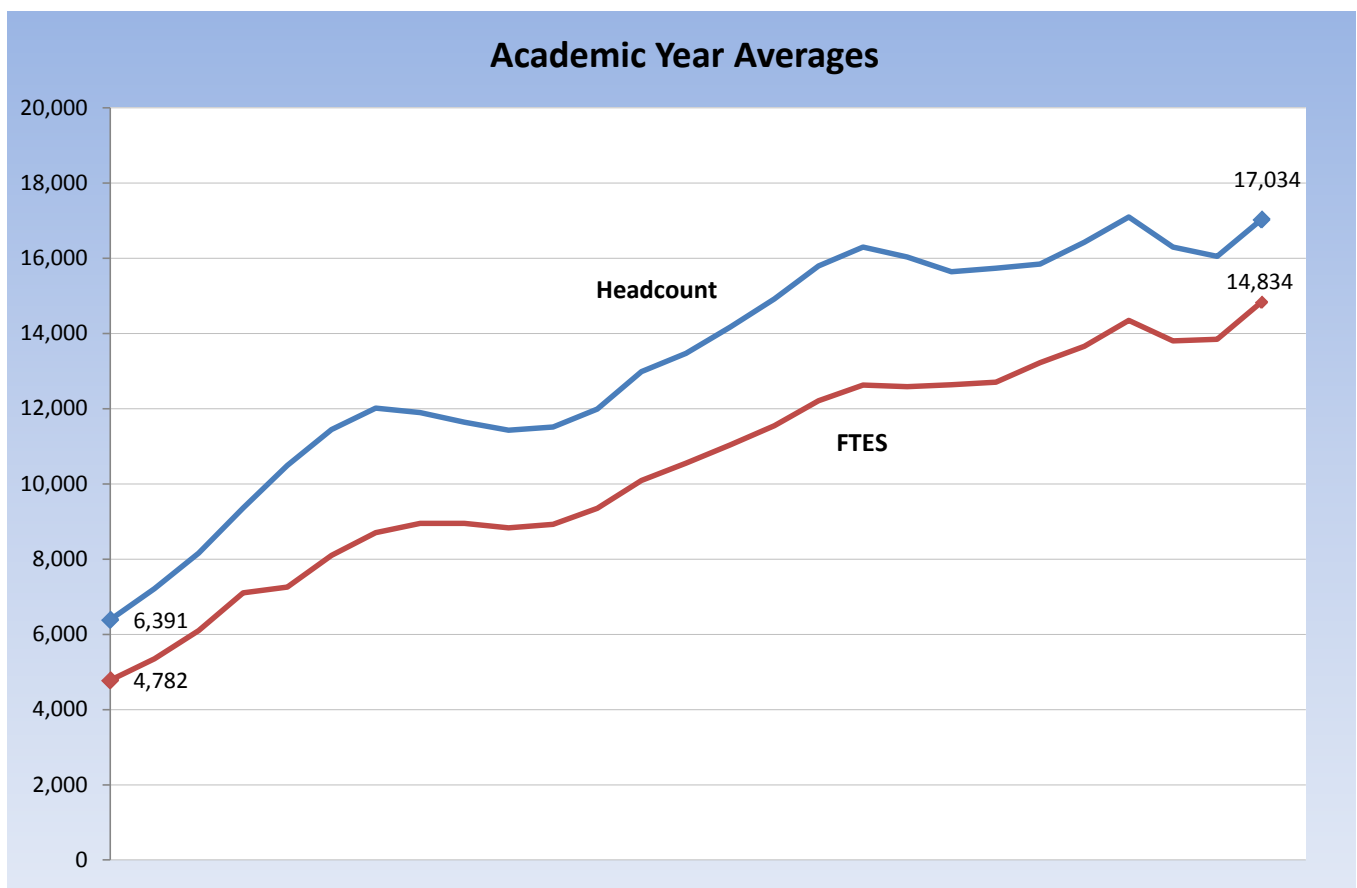

Welcome to the CSUSB Statistical Factbook!

Our Mission:

The Office of Institutional Research at California State University, San Bernardino is committed to the generation and dissemination of reliable reports and studies in a timely manner including efficient reporting to various constituencies, evaluation of our institution through survey research and data analysis, and collaboration with our academic leaders in support of decision-making, assessment, and quality improvement.

We are pleased to introduce an online data warehouse called the DARTboard (Data Assessment & Report Tool) at <http://irdata.csusb.edu/>. This site was designed to put data in the hands of the campus community with self-study authors, Dean's Offices, department chairs, and grant writers in mind. This homemade web interface answers questions like "how many students do we have..." and "what are the retention and graduation rates for....".

The Factbook reflects changes to statistical data reporting that occurred several years ago. Historically, a fulltime equivalent student (FTES) comprised 15 units per quarter (45 per year). The year 2006-07 brought a differentiation for students in Master's programs for whom 12 units became one FTES. Since Fall 2007, a doctoral student advanced to candidacy was defined as one FTES regardless of the number of units. The CSU System has also begun differentiating between California Residents and Non-Residents so a Residency distinction has been included on several tables. Also, majors in this Factbook are now reported as Academic Plan (local), rather than the traditional CSU Hegis majors, to make the Factbook relevant to colleges. Finally, Fall 2009 reflects a new coding of ethnicity mandated by the Federal government. While some tables provide historical statistics based on the current coding rules, most tables will reflect the definitions in effect at those past times.

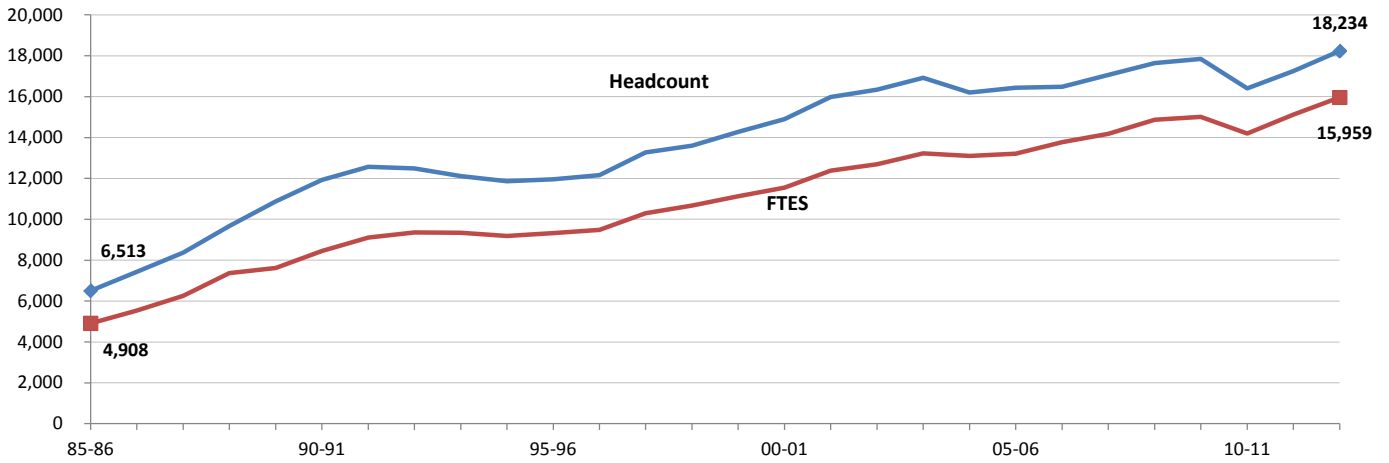

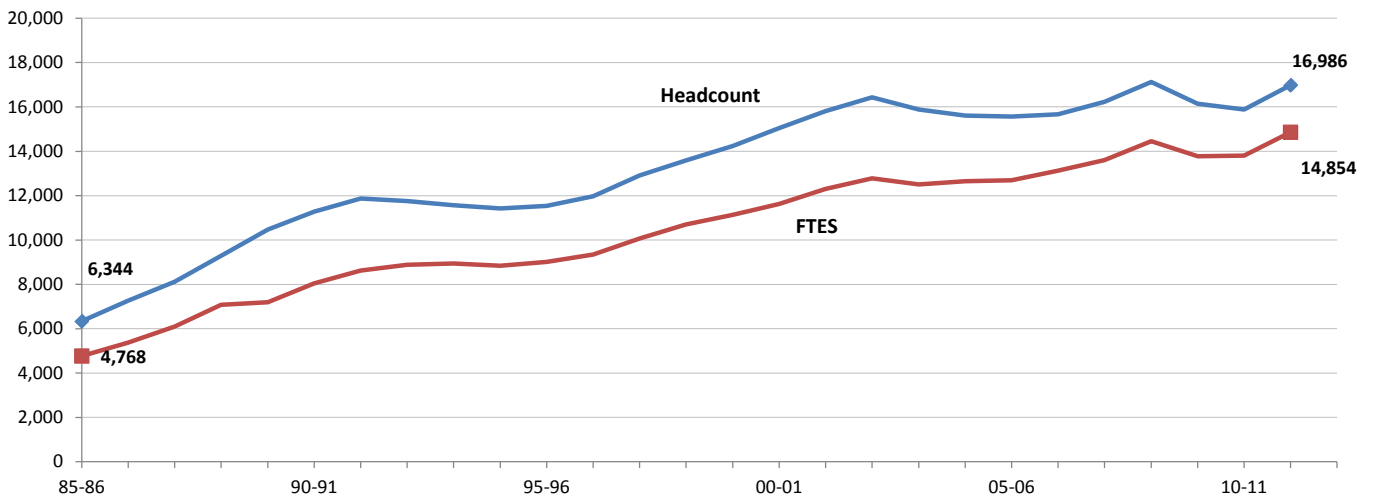

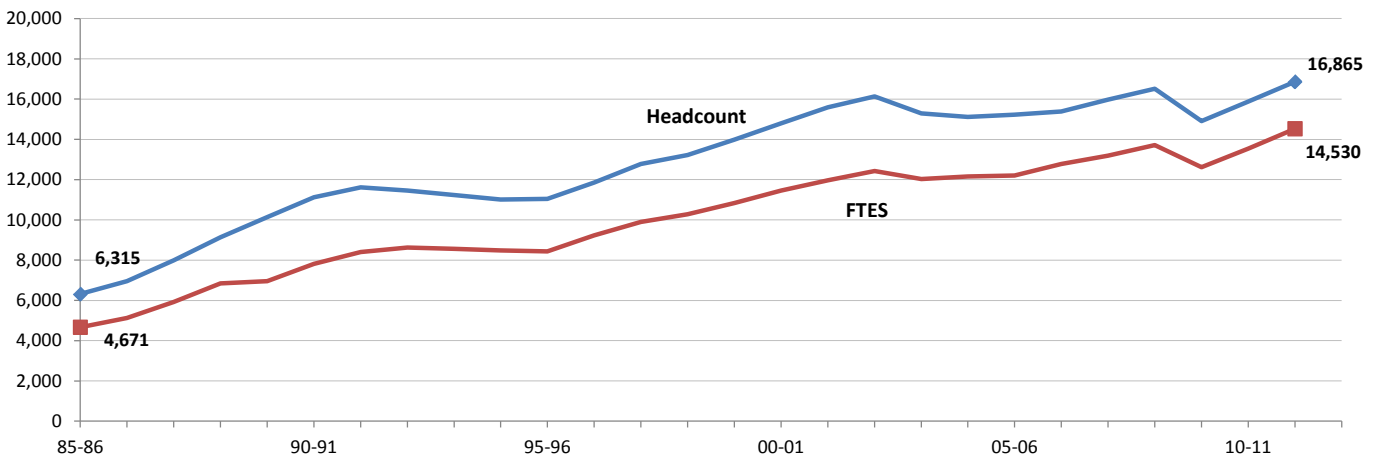
Fall Trends
