PURPOSE & ELIGIBILITY

The purpose of this Faculty Learning Community (NFLC), facilitated by TRC Director Kim Costino, is to provide faculty members in years 2-4 with time, space, support, and resources to investigate and integrate high-impact, evidence-based teaching practices in a course (or courses) of their choosing. Participants will be expected to meet monthly as a group, to read and participate in discussions about the literature regarding evidence-based teaching practices, how people learn, and best course design principles and to integrate and assess the impact of at least one evidence-based teaching into a course s/he will teach by Fall 2016. The NFLC will meet one Friday every month, January-December 2016, 11:00-1:00.
