

CSUSB General Education Learning Outcomes

General Education at CSUSB fosters intellectual rigor and exploration whereby students understand and investigate the foundations and implications of ideas, theories, beliefs, and expressions. The program uses a multidisciplinary approach to encourage ongoing, self-motivated learning and to inform student creativity, reasoning, problem-solving, expression, and responsible action. It's a process whereby students:

1. Learning How to Learn/Metacognition: Develop awareness of their learning processes, becoming reflective, self-directed learners who are able to apply and adapt their processes of learning in new contexts.
2. Thinking Critically: Think critically, evaluate, analyze, and solve problems employing multiple methods of reasoning.
3. Critical Literacies: Analyze the ways that information and expression, including quantitative, technological, artistic, oral, and written modes, shape and are shaped by social contexts.
4. Global Perspective: Develop the ability to understand global contexts so they are prepared to contribute to an ever changing and pluralistic world.
5. Integrative Learning: Become aware of connections and differences across disciplines and learning experiences in order to frame and address ideas and questions they encounter in their lives.
6. Ethical Responsibility: Recognize that they are ethically responsible for the impact that their ideas, decisions, and actions have upon their lives, and on local and global communities.
7. Collaboration: Explore and understand multiple perspectives in order to collaborate and communicate effectively with diverse people across a variety of contexts and cultures.
