(PC 215Carjacking)

Details:

On Jan 14, 2017 at approximately 8:30 PM a(n) carjacking occurred
on the campus of California State University San Bernardino.

This crime occurred at Parking Lot F1 near Arrowhead Village Building 4.

The victim of the crime was a student of the University.

Suspect/s and/or Vehicle/s Information:

On January 14, 2017, at about 8:30pm, a CSUSB student (victim) parked his vehicle in Parking Lot F1, near Arrowhead Village Building 4. After exiting his vehicle, the victim observed a dark colored hatchback style vehicle stop along the north curb line of Northpark Blvd. The vehicle was occupied by two unknown suspects. The suspects activated the vehicle's hazard lights as if they were having car trouble. The victim then observed one suspect, a Black male exit the vehicle and walk in the victim's direction. As the suspect approached, the victim observed the suspect pointing a silver handgun at him. The suspect ordered the victim to handover his wallet, cell phone and other property. The suspect then ordered the victim to start his vehicle. Once the victim's vehicle was started, the suspect ordered him to leave. The suspect entered the victim's vehicle and drove away. The suspect was last seen driving Westbound on Northpark Blvd. The second suspect was also seen fleeing Westbound on Northpark Blvd.

Suspect #1: Black male, early 20's wearing a black jacket.

Suspect #2: No Description provided.

The vehicle stolen was a gold 2007 Toyota Camry.
