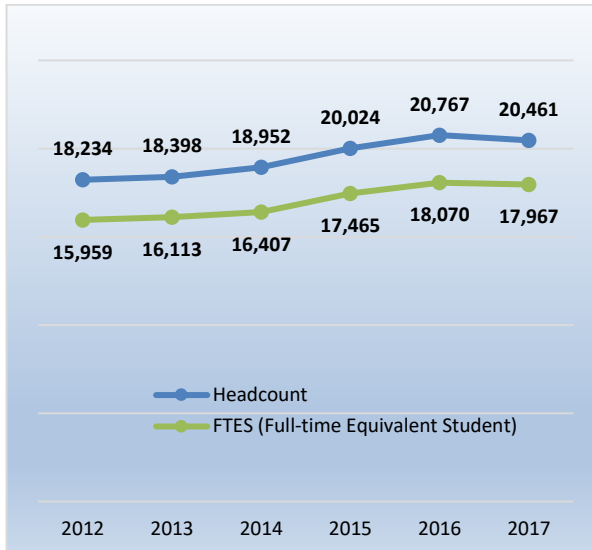

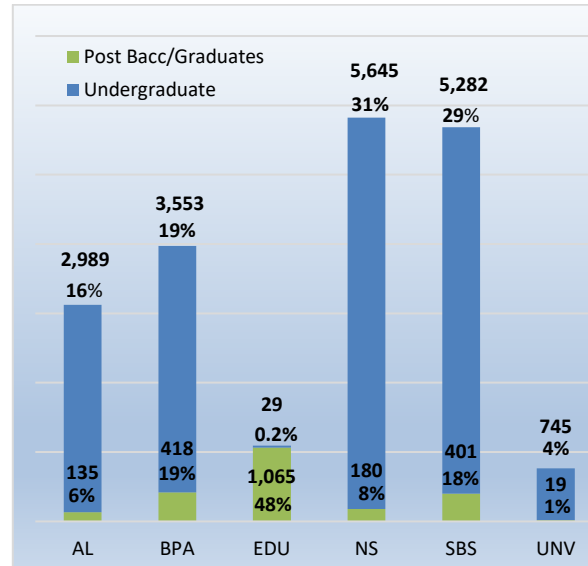

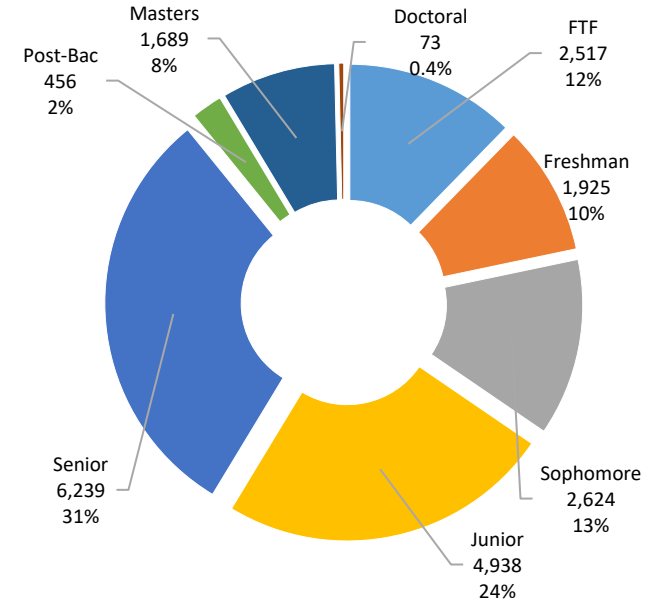
Headcount & FTES Fall 2012-2017



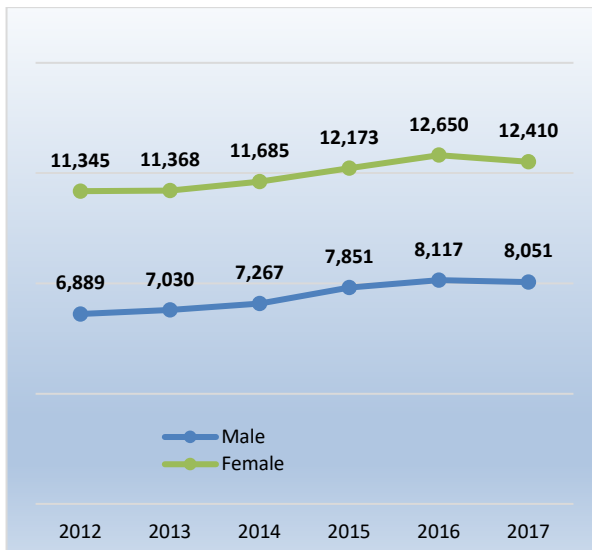
Headcount by College of Major Fall 2017



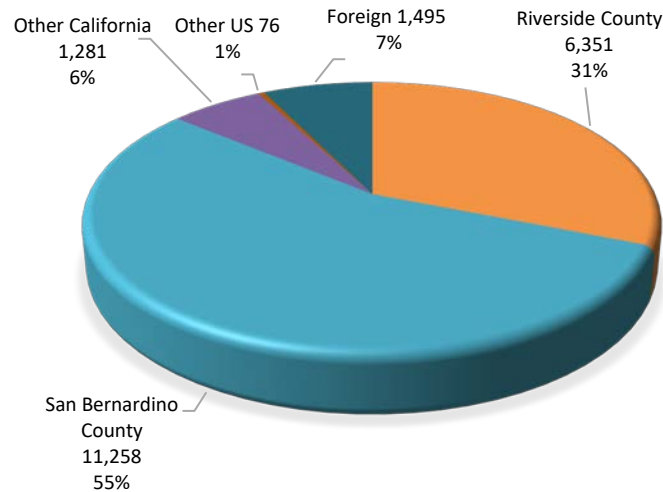
Headcount by Student Level Fall 2017



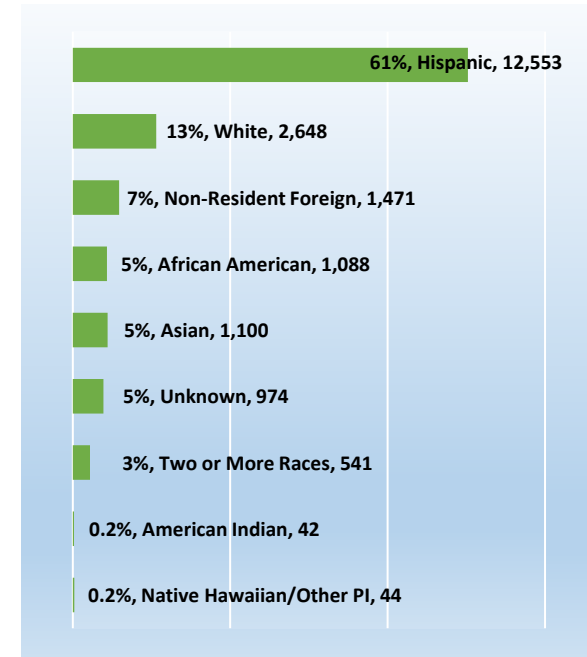
Headcount by Gender Fall 2012-2017
