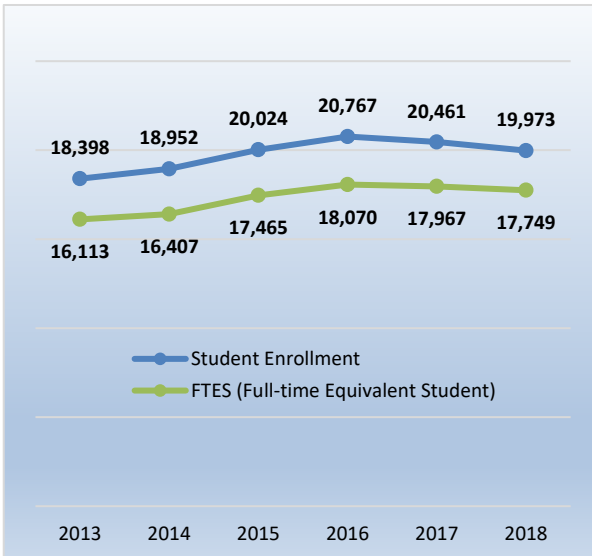

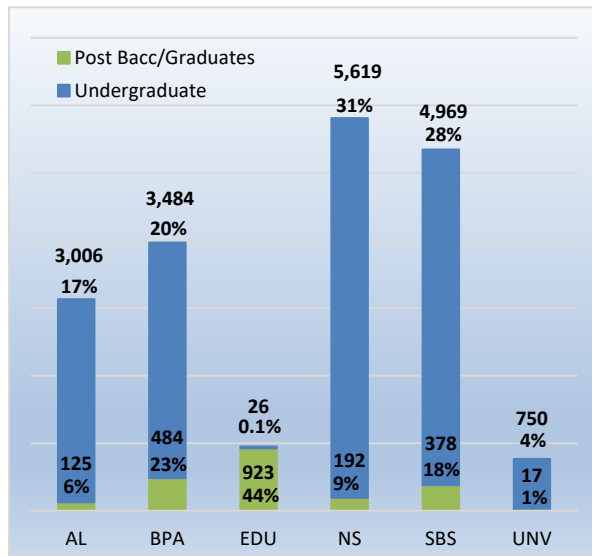

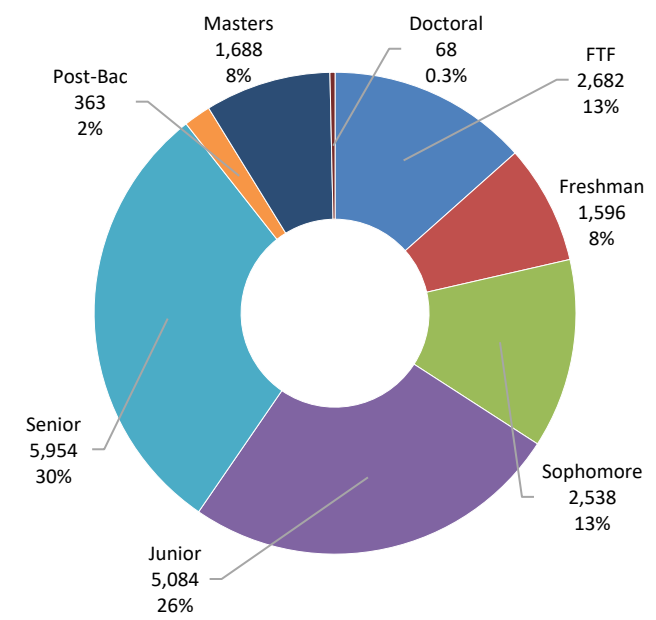
Student Enrollment & FTES Fall 2013-2018



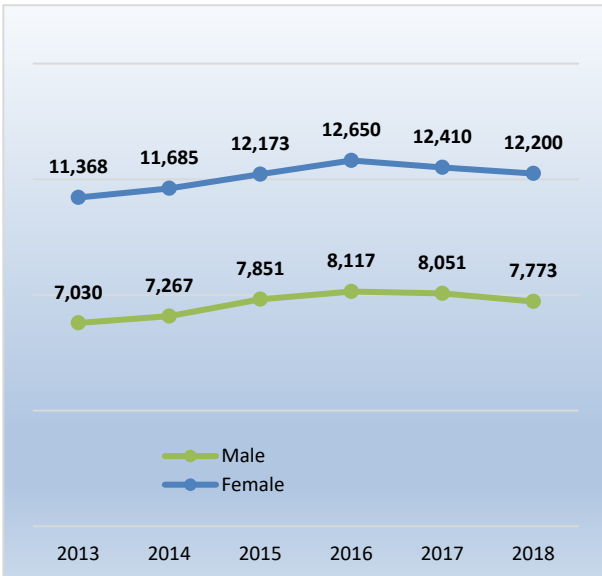
Student Enrollment by College of Major Fall 2018



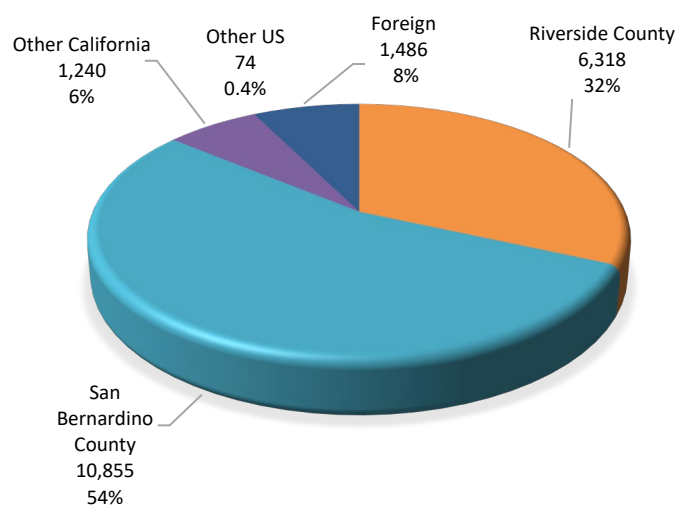
Student Enrollment by Level Fall 2018



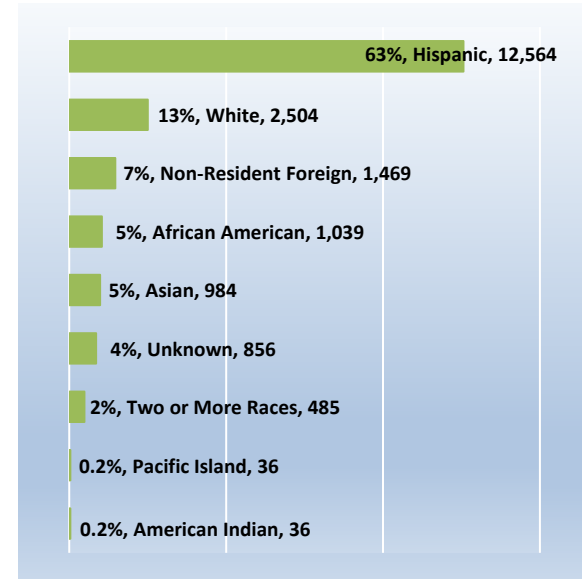
Student Enrollment by Gender Fall 2013-2018
