- 3. The MAC address will be displayed.

- 1. Select **System Settings** and go to **Internet**.
- 2. Select View MAC Address.
- 3. The MAC address for the unit will be displayed on this screen.

Nintendo 3DS

- 1. From the **Home** menu, select the **System Settings** Icon.
- 2. Select Internet Settings.
- 3. Tap Other Information.
- 4. Tap Confirm MAC Address to view the systems MAC address.
