Addition of Degree Concentration CSUSB Bachelor of Music Degree

Introduction

CSUSB's Department of Music proposes the addition of a Concentration in Music Education to its existing Bachelor of Music program. Simultaneously with this request, the department is requesting a clarifying change in the degree program's title from "Bachelor of Music in Performance" to just "Bachelor of Music". A separate document attached with this proposal supports the degree name change. The exact title of the proposed CSU "subpogram", including the revised degree title, will be "Bachelor of Music with a Concentration in Music Education".
