At the Veterans Success Center we receive many questions throughout the day. This blog will assist students with many questions that may not be covered in the FAQs. We recently had a dependent come into our office requesting information about continuing his education. He recently received his Bachelor's degree from another university and was interested in taking classes at CSUSB to fulfill requirements needed to attend a local Professional school. At his previous school he was using the California Fee Waiver, and was interested in using it here as well to fulfill the requirements of the Professional school.

Unfortunately, as of January 2013, in order to open seats in classes that are overcrowded, CSUSB no longer admits postbach students. This standard is already enforced at University of California, Riverside, and probably more local universities.

The only way to take classes if you already have a Bachelor's degree is to go through the campus' College of Extended Learning, through Open University. The College of Extended Learning does not accept payment of the California Fee Wavier because CEL is not a state supported program.

A strong recommendation to students is to know what your academic goal is to avoid the need to return to college as a postbach student. If your goal happens to change during the middle of your education, ensure you make the necessary adjustments. You can change or add a major and/or minor by visiting the Records, Registration, and Evaluations Office for a minimal fee
