Supervise Recreational Climbing facilities to ensure that activities are being conducted

safely and appropriately.

Provide a welcoming, inclusive environment for staff and participants.

Provide a friendly, upbeat and customer service oriented environment at all times.

Check out and keep a record of climbing equipment rentals.

Enforce policies to ensure a fun and safe environment

Qualifications: Education: Must be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) units at California State University,

San Bernardino and maintain a quarterly and cumulative G.P.A. above 2.0.
