Veteran, Student and Community Involvement

Partnering with the Wounded Warrior Project, many of our coaches are wounded or disabled veterans whose indeterminable spirit exemplifies how disabilities are only a small part of the person, not the whole. For our students, we provide service-learning experiences which allow them to gain practical work experience in their field of study. Combined with the amazing amount of support from our many community volunteers, the DisABILITY Sports Festival is an opportunity that forever changes the lives of everyone involved.
