TPID certificate posted in accordance with State regulations on office peg board. TPID certificate is outdated. A new copy will be ordered and mailed to office to post in place of old certificate. CTL records of waste tire disposal are available and correctly completed. Waste tires are stored outdoors within a block enclosure. The block enclosure is adjacent to street outside the EHS secured fencing. Iron gates meant to secure block enclosure are broken/not functional. Because enclosure is accessible by the public an 'Area of Concern' is given under 14 CCR section 17352 (c). Iron gates need to be re-attached or fixed and enclosure secured.
