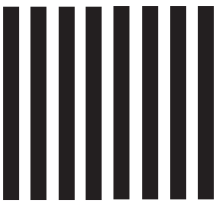

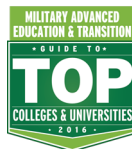


Welcome

Getting Admitted

Admissions

In general, you must have completed high school with a grade of "C" or better in the A-G college prep courses. Students are encouraged to seek official guidance from admissions counselors throughout the admissions process. Steps for admission to CSUSB and its Palm Desert Campus include:

- 1 Make an appointment with CSUSB's Admissions Veterans Liaison Counselors to ensure you are eligible for admission.
- 2 Submit an application online at www.csumentor.edu.

- 3 Upon receiving the confirmation email from CSUSB, mail or bring any additional documents requested to Admissions and Student Recruitment, University Hall, Room 107.
- 4 Activate your MyCoyote account by visiting mycoyote.cms.csusb.edu and selecting "Activate Your Account." Closely follow the directions on the subsequent Web page.
- 5 Pay the Enrollment Confirmation Deposit, unless waived, and accept the offer of admission.
- 6 Attend the appropriate SOAR session for your college.
- 7 After you register for classes you will then be able to submit your VA benefit forms to the CSUSB Certifying Official for Veterans Education Benefits.

Transfer Students

Speak with the Admissions Veterans Liaison Counselor to ensure your previous school's credits are transferable and that you have enough units to transfer as an upper division student (60 semester units or 90 quarter units). CSUSB is able to admit lower division transfer student veterans on a case-by-case basis. To determine if you are eligible, contact CSUSB's Admissions Veterans Liaison Counselors.

getting admitted

Benefits/Financial Aid

Our experienced VA education benefits and financial aid staff can help you with coordinating your GI Bill, Kicker awards, tuition assistance and veteran or dependent education awards. There are a variety of sources for financial support for veterans, active duty military, reservists and dependents. Each has its own forms, processes and timetables. Though receipt of VA benefits is considered in the determination of a student veteran's level of aid, collecting the Post 9/11 GI Bill does not disqualify you from other types of financial aid. You should also file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).



GI Bill

The Certifying Official for Veterans Education Benefits provides guidance on completing and filing VA claim forms for federal and state education assistance programs. The certifying official can also assist with special registration procedures required for students who are sponsored through one of the VA fee waiver programs (for dependents and disabled veterans). Follow the steps listed below to receive your VA education benefits:

- 1 Register for classes.
- 2 If you have not used your GI Bill, apply to the VA for your education benefits at <http://gibill.va.gov>.
- 3 If you are a veteran, give the school certifying official a copy of your DD-214 and your education benefits award letter when you receive it. If you are in the reserves applying for Chapter 1606, you will need to submit a copy of your NOBE, which you can obtain from your unit. There will be other forms to fill out, depending on the type of VA educational benefit you receive. The certifying official will guide you through the process.
- 4 Each quarter, contact the certifying official to let her know that you would like your enrollment certified and the number of credits you are taking. You can email her at vetinfo@csusb.edu to schedule an appointment to complete the certification process.

- 5** On the last day of each month, verify your enrollment with the VA using the WAVE system: <https://www.gibill.va.gov/wave> or by calling the phone verification system at 1 (877) 823-2378. You do not have to do this if you are receiving benefits under Chapter 33 or 35.
- 6** Notify the certifying official immediately if there are any changes in the number of credits you are taking (add/drop, withdrawal, etc.), if you are being activated, called for training, deployed or change your major.

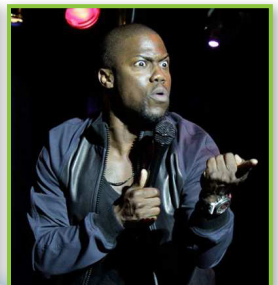

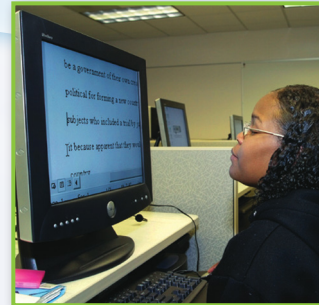

Over 60 Program

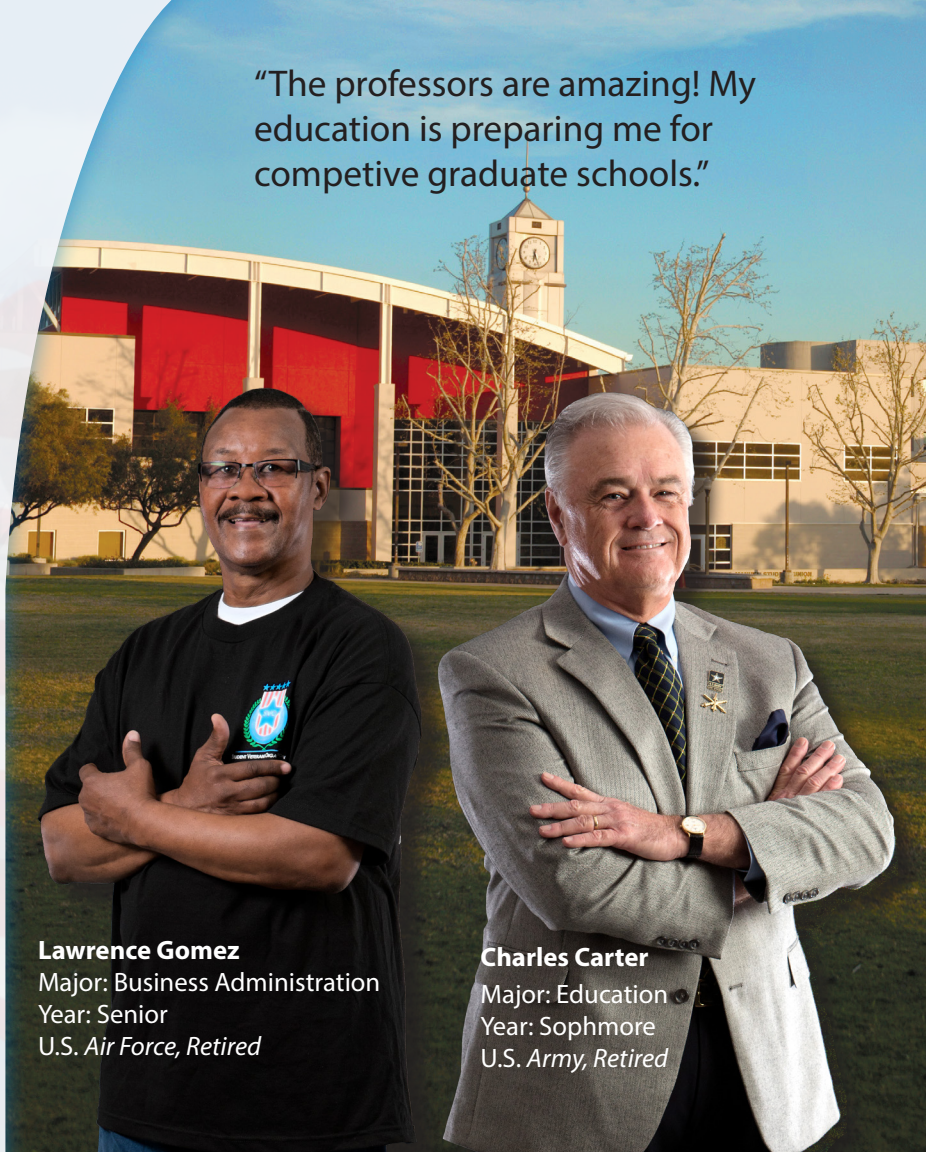
CSUSB offers a program that allows California residents, 60 years of age or older, to enroll in regular session courses without payment of certain specified fees. All regular admission requirements must be met. The program is required to adhere to the following standards:

- Enrollment shall be limited to persons who are California residents as defined by the Education Code, are 60 years of age or older, and are eligible for admission to the university.
- Students in this program pay a reduced fee, their registration time will be during Priority 5 registration.
- The reduction of fees does not include books, parking or lab fees associated with any courses.
- California residents turning 60 years of age during a quarter that is already in session will not be added until the beginning of the following quarter.
