\*Please note:

- All activities listed on the Master Field Calendar are a required part of the field program. Students who do not attend the events will not receive credit for field.
- Field Seminar schedules will be provided by August 2019. There are eight seminars per year. Students are required to attend ALL seminars to pass field.
- Internship start dates depend on where a student is placed. The official start date for field is 9/18 or 9/19 but some agencies require an early start date. Students who are required to start early were notified prior to interviewing with an agency.
- Students are responsible for determining internship start date and ensuring minimum number of required hours are completed.
- Students are REQUIRED to discuss with their assigned agency field instructor winter and spring break time off. Students may be required to attend field practicum over breaks due to client needs. Students in school based internships need to discuss schedule and plan hours around Monday holidays or alternative schedules based on school site schedule. Do not assume the schedule is the same as CSUSB.
