

2016-17 MPA Estimated Tuition Costs

Students often ask about the total cost of the MPA degree or cost per credit.

Costs for the MPA vary depending on

- 1) California resident or non-resident status
- 2) Number of classes taken per quarter
- 3) Number of online classes taken
- 4) Whether pre-requisites are required

These estimates are based on the [CSUSB Tuition and Fees webpage](#)

The MPA degree consists of 12 classes at 4 units per class or 48 quarter units.
(not counting prerequisites or the Comprehensive Exam)

Tuition costs for the degree (assuming no changes) are estimated to be:

California Resident taking only traditional classes (no online)

For one class a quarter $\$1,685 \times 12 = \$20,220$ or \$421 per unit

For two classes a quarter $\$2,629 \times 6 = \$15,774$ or \$329 per unit

For three classes a quarter $\$2,620 \times 4 = \$10,516$ or \$219 per unit

California Resident taking only online classes (add \$360 per class)

For one class a quarter $\$2,045 \times 12 = \$24,540$ or \$511 per unit

For two classes a quarter $\$3,349 \times 6 = \$20,094$ or \$419 per unit

For three classes a quarter $\$3,709 \times 4 = \$14,836$ or \$309 per unit

Non-resident and International Students – Add \$248 per unit

$\$248 \times 48 = \$11,904$
