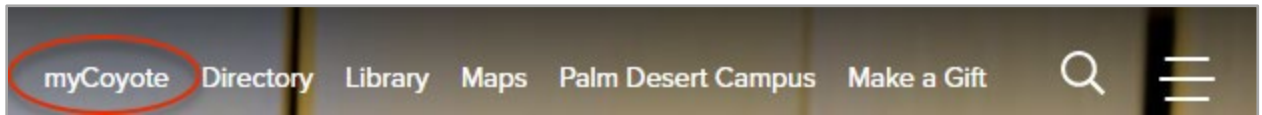



Coyote First STEP Math

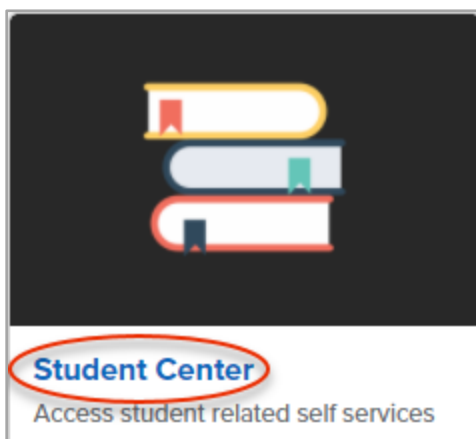
1. Log into **myCoyote** <https://my.csusb.edu/>.



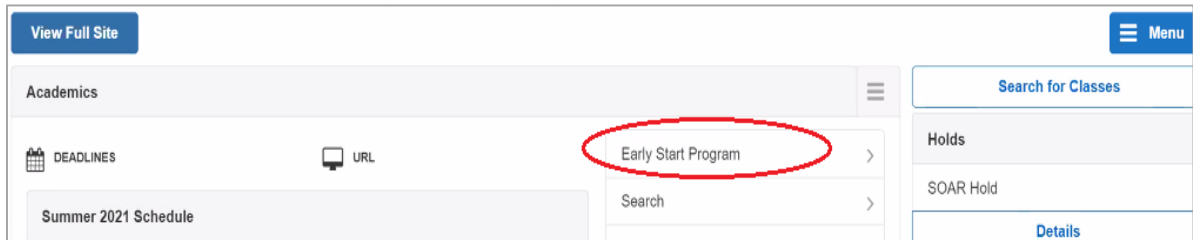
2. Use your 9-digit CSUSB Coyote ID number and password.

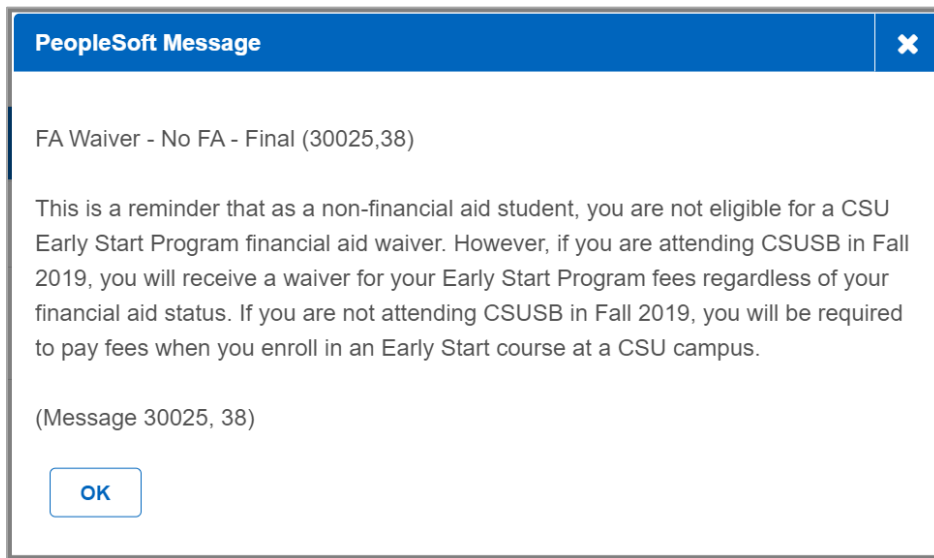
3. In myCoyote, scroll down and click the **Student Center** tile (Image with 3 stacked books).
