Advocates are faculty members from various departments within JHBC who serve as liaisons between the OAE and their departments. **12 Advocates**

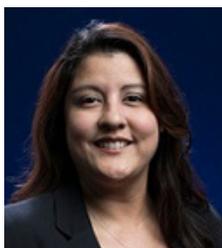


JHBC Paves The Way
