

3RD JHBC PAVES THE WAY

The 3rd Annual JHBC Paves the Way took place on March 11th, 2022, at 2PM via Zoom. Paves the Way is an event during which faculty members from the Jack H. Brown College of Business and Public Administration (JHBC) engage in discussions about Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) in the college.

For this year's event, the JHBC Office of Academic Equity had a panel of JHBC faculty who addressed issues about: gender equity, teaching load, discrimination among faculty members, work-life balance, the impact of the pandemic, support for DEI, information transparency, faculty mentoring, as well as the validation of faculty members' experience and collegiality.

Approximately 25 faculty members were present for the annual discussion and have asked that the event not be recorded.

Faculty attending the event expressed the need to continue the conversation. Dr. Francisca Beer will have a meeting with the dean to determine how faculty members suggestions and questions can best be addressed.
