




#### Religion Hate Crime Up 27% With Jews Top Target In Cities Again, +28% in 2022; Anti-Sikh Doubles in 2021


In 2022 religion targeted hate crime continued to both climb and diversify, rising 27%, in major American cities - quadruple the percentage increase for overall hate crime in surveyed cities that year, according to research by the non-partisan *Center for the Study of Hate & Extremism (CSHE)* at California State University, San Bernardino.


Jews, again, were most targeted, with 470 hate crimes in 2022 or 78% of the religion total and a 28% increase, followed by Muslims with an 8% share, 50 crimes and a 16% rise. Catholics had a 13% drop to 26 hate crimes and those of "other" non-Christian faiths were up 117% to 25. Outside of surveyed cities, CSHE found at least four religiously motivated homicides in 2022. Three were committed against Shia Muslims by an alleged Sunni extremist in New Mexico and the homicide of an Arizona Catholic professor on Yom Kippur, by a mentally unstable man who believed him to be Jewish.



#### Latest 2022 CSHE Data & New FBI 2021 Totals Shows Shifts & Increases


Mirroring CSHE's 27% 2022 rise, newly released national, but older revised FBI 2021 totals show religion hate crime rose 28%, to 1,590 - the second highest bureau total since 1991 and the most since 2001, with some faiths hitting records.






FBI overall hate crime rose, 31% in 2021 to a new modern record of 10,840, up from 8,263 in 2020, although the bureau also uses a smaller alternative 2021 data set to arrive at a lower overall increase of 11.6%. For 2021 of "the 8,327 hate crime offenses classified as crimes against persons in the updated dataset, 43.2% were intimidation, 35.5 % were simple assault, and 20.1% were aggravated assault," as well as 19 murders, the FBI noted in a release. The above breakdown is taken from the more comprehensive FBI data set and thus varies from their release.

Anti-Catholic 2021 hate crime hit a record back to 1991, when FBI hate crime data collection commenced, with a 33% increase to 97, though CSHE showed a 2022 decline in major cities. Catholics are the largest faith group in the United States. Neither anti-Jewish nor anti-Muslim hate crime totals approached records, despite 2021 increases. Reflecting diversification in crimes, in 2021 Sikhs were the second most targeted faith group in FBI reported hate crime, displacing Muslims who have held the position since 2001. Anti-Jewish hate crime in 2022 hit decade highs in major cities.






Hate crimes at U.S. houses of worship also rose 12.7%, in 2021 to 329, up from 292 the year prior, while in California the increase was 47%. According to the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, "At least 250 incidents [of vandalism, arson, and property damage] have occurred across 42 states and the District of Columbia since May 2020. Incidents include arson, statues beheaded, limbs cut, smashed, and painted, gravestones defaced with swastikas and anti-Catholic language and American flags next to them burned, and other destruction and vandalism."





# Jews Most Frequent Target, But Other Non-Christian Faiths Also See Rising Hate






Jews with a 20% rise remained the most targeted religious group for FBI reported 2021 hate crime, as they have every year records have been kept. This is also true in CSHE's 2022 and historic data. In CSHE's independently collected major

city survey for 2021 anti-Jewish hate crime rose more than the totals reached by the FBI, by 59%, due to a surge during the Gaza War, but also in likely smaller part because of better coordination between victims, advocacy groups and authorities in major cities that have higher Jewish populations.

Anti-Jewish crimes, the largest religion sample, rose an average of 28% in 2022 in a CSHE study of 21 cities. New York City hit a modern annual record for both anti-Jewish hate crime and overall hate crime. Indeed, New York City had the highest total for anti-Jewish hate crime in 2022 for any U.S. city since 1991 — when modern FBI data collection commenced. The 2.14 million Jewish residents in the New York-Northern New Jersey metro area are 10.6% of the region's population and constitute 31% of the nation's Jews. Jews were the plurality of all hate crime targets there, and at 261 antisemitic hate crimes in 2022, those would rank above the overall individual city totals of all but New York and Los Angeles.



New York City police reported about the same number of anti-Jewish hate crime in May 2021 alone as they did in the whole first quarter. In 2021 anti-Jewish hate crime in New York and other cities spiked in May around violence in the Middle East, but in 2022 there was also a spike in the fall around the time of musical artist Ye's anti-Semitic online tirades. November anti-Jewish hate crime totals in New York were 125% the same month the year before. Similarly, in Los Angeles antisemitic attacks declined into the summer, but rose in the fall, closing out the year with a 12% increase. In Chicago anti-Jewish cases grew sixfold in 2022 from 6 the year before to 26.

Still, reflecting a diversification and growth of other faiths being targeted and reporting more, Jews nationally have for decades been trending down as a proportion of all hate crime, and religion hate crime. In 2021 a bare majority of 51% of all religious hate crime and 7.5% of overall cases were directed against Jews. In 2022 Jews constituted 78% of all religion hate crime in major U.S. cities surveyed by CSHE – in places with far higher proportions of Jewish residents. In contrast, nationally over the past ten years, Jews averaged about 11% of all hate crime and 57% of religion directed ones, according to the FBI. In the 1990s Jews ranged between 79% and 88% of all religious hate crime.

Because Jews are twice as represented in America's largest cities than in the nation overall, anti-Semitic hate crime totals are higher in those places as well. Various Jewish advocacy organizations are active in anti-hate initiatives and police hate crime units operate in larger cities. America's estimated 6.8 million Jews are about 2.1% of the nation's population, but in the 21 top metro areas they constitute about 4.4% of residents.

The first anti-Jewish homicide of the decade occurred with murder of a Catholic professor at the University of Arizona, mistakenly believed to be Jewish by his mentally ill killer. Another, March 2020 death resulted from a stabbing at a Hannukah party the previous year in Monsey, New York, by another mentally ill bigot, who had previously referenced both Hitler and Black Hebrew Israelites. The killing of a British violent Salafist Jihadist kidnapper of a rabbi and synagogue congregants by federal authorities in Colleyville, Texas on January 15, 2022, was also not enumerated as he was a perpetrator. Various thwarted threats amid the continuing invective targeting Jews and the elevated promotion of mass killings of them and other minorities strongly suggest that we are now in a tenuous and temporary pause relating to mass plots against Jews and others by loners or small cells.


In the previous decade at least 19 people, not all of them Jews, were murdered in anti-Jewish hate crime homicides in the United States according to CSHE, compared to four in the decade prior. Last decade 16 occurred in 2018 and 2019 alone, with a clear majority committed by white supremacists, although some were done by fringe Black separatists. The Tree of Life massacre on October 27, 2018, by a xenophobic white supremacist who posted his intentions on GAB, killed 11 and was the worst mass killing of Jews in modern American history.

Public displays of antisemitism have become more brazen and wide-reaching ranging due to a spread in conspiracism, religious nationalism, anti-government sentiment, and replacement doctrine in an easily exploited social media landscape by domestic and international malefactors. In the modern white supremacist world Jew hatred has both racial and religious Nazified and Protocols of Zion influenced conspiratorial roots depicting them as biological parasites and traitors. Bigotry relating to Jewish "Open Society" philanthropist George Soros, domestic religious nationalism, Q Anon, Middle East conflicts, falsehoods on Jews role in slavery and COVID response are commonly found in social media and politics. In Pennsylvania, the Republican gubernatorial candidate's conspiracism ranged from election denial to Jewish day schools. Anti-Jewish conspiracies range across nationalities and ideology and are part of a transnational trend.



Los Angeles figures from 2021/22 are also higher due in part to an alternate method of counting victims in 2021-2 which was 27% higher for overall LAPD hate crime.

Over the last two years CSHE found anti-Jewish hate crime in major cities have increased to its highest level in over a decade. Jewish civil rights and advocacy groups like the Anti-Defamation League (ADL), Wiesenthal Center, American Jewish Committee (AJC) and Bend the Arc have found increases anti-Jewish criminal and non-criminal incidents, public and online displays of Jew hatred and rising concern in the Jewish community. The ADL enumerated a record 2,717 anti-Jewish criminal and non-criminal "hate incidents" in 2021 for a 34% increase over 2020's 2,026 total with 131 assaults, a 167% increase over 2020, with some analysts expecting, yet another rise in 2022, based on existing hate crime data. A 2021 AJC survey of U.S. Jews found 90% thought antisemitism is a problem, with 82% perceiving an increase, and 12% reporting being targeted online.

Still PEW research finds that Jews are among the most warmly viewed of any faith by Americans. Nevertheless, the ADL found an increase in those Americans believing at least one anti-Jewish trope rose from 61% in 2019 to 85% in 2022, and a near doubling to 20% in those who believed most of the tropes presented to them. Over recent decades anti-Jewish hate crime has spiked during Middle East conflicts between Israelis and Palestinians, election times, Holidays, and Halloween.






Anti-Jewish crimes surged in May 2021 during the Gaza War and ended the year up 59% in major U.S. cities. Jews have been the top religious bias nationally for hate crime since 1991 and are consistently the top overall bias target in New York City, where one in six American Jews reside. Jews were the plurality of all hate crime

targets there, and at a revised 196 anti-Semitic hate crimes, those would rank above the individual city totals of all but a handful of places nationally.

In 2020 the FBI found nationally, that 166 of 232 known anti-Jewish hate offenders, or 72% were white, 16% Black, and 6% Hispanic, but in New York City Black and white offenders were evenly divided, likely impacted by all those groups being concentrated together in densely populated areas of the city, making all interactions, including aggressive ones more prevalent. A similar phenomenon occurs with respect to race and ethnicity in places like Los Angeles.





#### Anti-Sikh Hate Crimes Double To New Multi-Year FBI High in 2021




Anti-Sikh hate crimes hit FBI multi-year highs in 2021 and more than doubled the prior year's reported totals - rising 108% in one year from 89 to 185. The FBI first officially created a stand-alone category for anti-Sikh hate crime in 2015, after previously being categorized as "other" religion. In 2021 Anti-Sikh hate crime, for the first time, became the second most frequently targeted religion in the United States in FBI data. Sikhs are among the most disproportionately targeted groups for hate crime in the US. According to the Sikh Coalition, the 500-year-old faith is the world's fifth largest with one half million adherents residing in the United States, though most still reside in the Punjab region of South Asia. The coalition states: "Cultural and religious illiteracy, coupled with a distinct visible identity, has led to xenophobic violence

against Sikhs since their arrival in America more than a century ago." On August 5, 2012, a mass shooting by a neo-Nazi killed seven worshipers at a gurdwara in Oak Creek Wisconsin, while on September 15, 2001, Balbir Singh Sodhi was shot to death by a violent bigot while planting flowers. In April 2021, four of eight murdered employees at an Indiana Federal Express facility were Sikhs, although the FBI and local police maintained religious bias was not a key motivating factor.



Most of the other religion related categories with much smaller sample sizes also rose to multi-year highs in 2021, such as: anti-Hindu, anti-Protestant, anti-Buddhist, anti-"Other" Christian, anti-Church of Jesus Christ, anti-Multiple Faith, and anti-Agnostic/Atheist. Potentially reflecting conflict in Europe, a very small number of crimes against Eastern Orthodox faiths were seen, while previously none had been reported at all.



Anti-Muslim Hate Crime Spikes in 2021 and 2002


While the 9/11 period was the modern record for FBI reported anti-Muslim (and Arab, then categorized as "ethnic non-Latino") hate crime, there have been other significant spikes including most recently those found in 2021 FBI data as well as in CSHE multi-city survey totals for 2021 and 2022. According to the FBI, anti-Muslim hate crimes rose 38% in 2021, after dropping to the lowest level in a decade in FBI 2020 totals. CSHE 2021 totals from one dozen places show a similar 45% increase in anti-Muslim hate crime from 84 in 2020 to 122 the following year. Moreover, CSHE found another 16% rise in its 2022 survey.

Over a decade ago in 2010 there was also substantial rise in attacks on Muslim Americans who were targeted in the United States amid Middle East conflicts, a Times Square bombing plot and a fallacious bigoted conspiracy theory that President Obama was secretly of the Muslim faith.


These hate crimes spiked in the middle of the last decade to the highest levels since 2001, during a time of rising and mainstreamed anti-Muslim socio-political invective and publicized attacks by violent Salafist extremists, like ISIS. In December 2015 when Syrian refugees, the San Bernardino terror attack and then candidate Donald Trump's viral "Muslim Ban Proposal" dominated headlines anti-Muslim hate crimes spiked to the third highest levels since FBI

recordation in 1991. In the days following the Muslim ban proposal disaggregated FBI anti-Muslim/Arab hate crime increased 23% above the spike following the December 2, 2015, terror attack five days prior. Over the last 15 years a series of apparent anti-Muslim multiple homicide attacks by white supremacists targeting them or their supporters have occurred in North America, Europe, and New Zealand. A white supremacist "replacement" conspiracist murdered 51 in mosque attacks in New Zealand in 2019 and Canada has also experienced multi-fatality attacks in recent years.

Post 9/11 anti-Muslim U.S. hate crime peaked in 2016 as assaults even broke the 2001 record. A 2016 PEW poll revealed almost one half of respondents (49%) thought at least some Muslims in the U.S. are "anti-American." Related hate crimes increased and peaked during the Presidential election. The day after the election was the highest day for overall hate crime in 13 years and there was an anti-Muslim bomb plot scheduled by right wing Kansas extremists for that time. However, as Latinos increasingly became a target of xenophobic invective, hate crimes against them rose and FBI reported anti-Muslim hate crime in the U.S. declined precipitously into 2020 – an anomalous year for lower religious hate crime because of gathering and mass transit restrictions in major metro areas.

Los Angeles initial preliminary data for 2020 and 2021 reported totals for number of victims at 615, but the California Department of Justice standardized the data to state and national accounting methods to count incidents as events, some of which will have multiple victims. While most cities count by event, some may not, so there may disparities between the historic methods that some agencies use.
