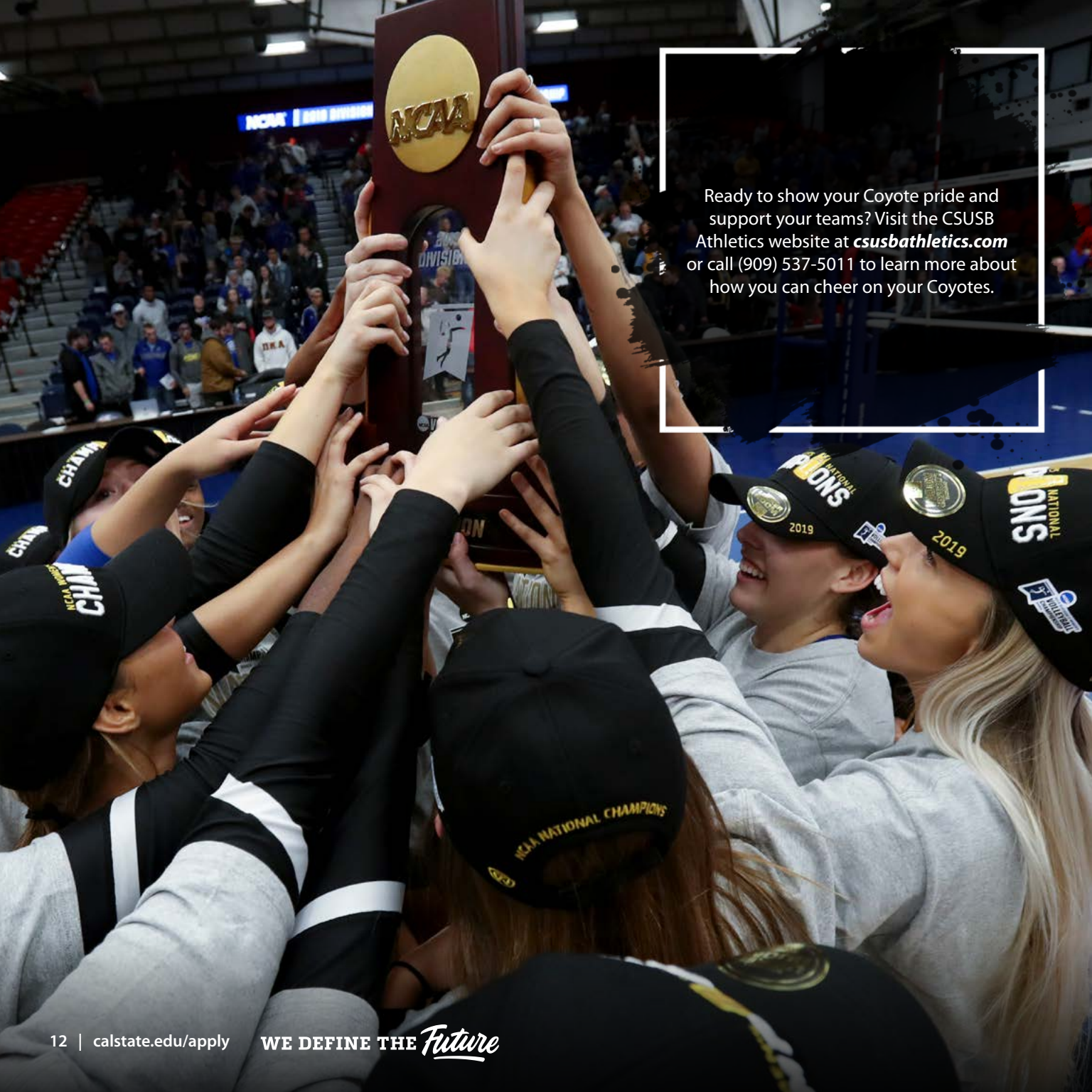

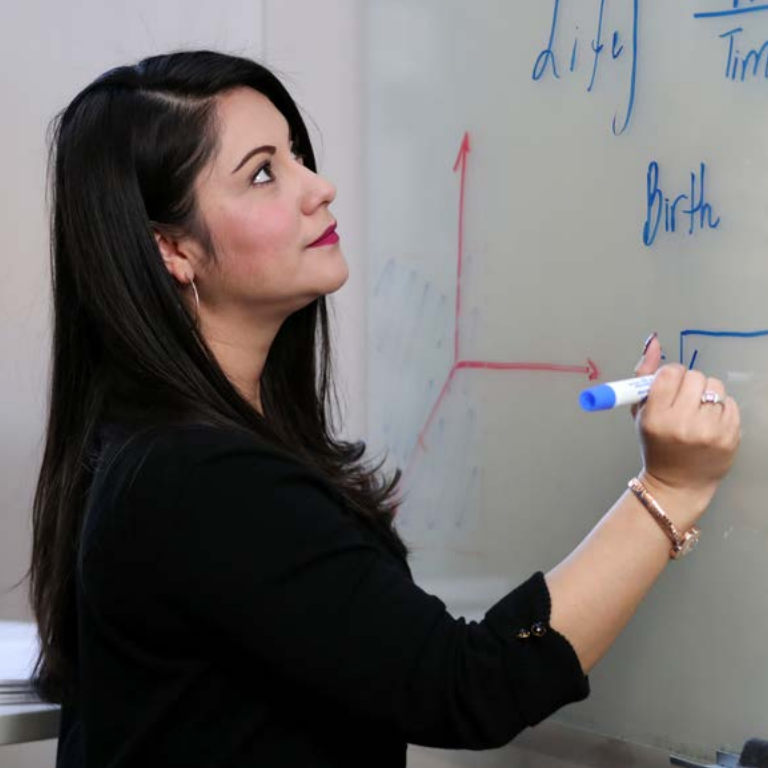


UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM & UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH OPPORTUNITIES

ADMISSIONS



APPLY TO CSUSB

Submit an application online beginning October 1st at: calstate.edu/apply

1. Check your personal email for an acknowledgement email with your Coyote ID number and CSUSB email account information.
2. Activate your MyCoyote account to view your application status online and determine if there are any other documents you need to turn in.
3. Review your CSUSB email, which will be available in your MyCoyote portal, for updates regarding required materials and your admission status.

All communications regarding your application will be sent to your CSUSB email.



ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

CSUSB accepts applications from first-time freshmen and upper-division transfer students from across California and around the world. As an impacted campus, CSUSB is dedicated to serving students from local high schools and community colleges. The requirements below are for non-impacted majors. Impacted majors have different/additional admission criteria - for more information visit csusb.edu/admissions/apply-csusb.

UPPER-DIVISION TRANSFER STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

CSUSB utilizes a Multi-Factor Admission Score to determine admissibility. This score is a combination of your GPA in A-G coursework and additional attributes such as work experience. The combination of GPA and attributes will provide a score that will determine whether you are eligible for admission to the campus and major you are applying for.

The minimum admission requirements for transfer students applying to CSUSB are 60 semester (90 quarter) units of transferable course work taken at a regionally accredited community college or university.

The SAT or ACT is no longer a requirement.

Transfer students are also required to complete the four basic skills with a "C-" or better: Speech/Oral Communication, Freshman Composition, Critical Thinking, and College-Level Math.

A critical component of the Multi-Factor Admission Score is the completion of the A-G college preparatory courses with grades of "C-" or better.

FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN REQUIREMENTS

First-Year applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- **Graduate High School:** All applicants must be a High School Graduate or Equivalent
- **GPA:** Earn a qualified "A-G" grade point average (GPA)
- **A-G courses:** Complete the 15 unit comprehensive "A-G pattern" with a grade of C- or better by high school graduation

As an impacted campus, at the first-year student level, San Bernardino will use Multi Factor Admission Score for all programs for California residents and graduates of California high schools earning a 2.50 or greater "a-g" GPA and Non-California residents may be eligible for admission to the CSU by earning a 3.00 or greater "a-g" GPA. CSU San Bernardino may also review applicants with an "a-g" GPA between 2.0 and 2.49 using supplemental factors.

All CSU listed fees should be regarded as estimates that are subject to change upon approval by the CSU Board of Trustees. CSUSB is a WICHE/WUE School for qualified students. Eligibility may affect tuition.

FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

More than 78 percent of our students receive financial aid awards averaging approximately \$10,700 per year. Of those students, 57 percent are funded entirely through grants and never have to pay a single penny for tuition.

KNOW YOUR AID

FEDERAL PELL GRANT

This is a grant provided by the federal government to help pay for educational expenses. Federal Pell Grants are awarded to students who display exceptional financial need and have not earned a bachelor's, graduate, or professional degree.

STATE UNIVERSITY GRANT

The State University Grant (SUG) is a CSU system wide award provides need-based awards to eligible students who are California residents or otherwise determined as eligible, such as AB 540-eligible students.

CAL GRANTS

A Cal Grant is money for college; it does not require repayment. To qualify, you must apply for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or California Dream Act Application (CADAA) by the deadline and meet the eligibility and financial requirements as well as any minimum GPA requirements. Your eligibility will be based on your FAFSA or CADAA responses, your verified Cal Grant GPA, the type of California colleges you list on your FAFSA, and whether you're a recent high school graduate.

DIRECT LOANS

Direct Loans are offered through a loan program administered by the federal government. These are financial aid awards that need to be repaid. Direct Subsidized Loans are loans made to eligible undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need to help cover educational costs. Direct Unsubsidized Loans are loans made to eligible undergraduate, graduate, and professional students, but eligibility is not based on financial need.

HOSPITALITY

With dozens of national and state parks, picturesque beach resorts, world-class music festivals and amusement parks, California is known around the globe as a travel destination. For this reason the demand of trained hospitality professionals: hotel and restaurant managers, event planners, tour operators and marketers, is high. To meet this demand, CSUSB Palm Desert Campus launched a new Hospitality Management Program.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

The Entrepreneurship Program at California State University, San Bernardino Palm Desert Campus is the first program of its kind in the entire CSU system and the only 3rd program in the entire state of California. The Entrepreneurship Program at the Palm Desert Campus is designed to offer students a business degree to provide a comprehensive education to launch entrepreneurial and new business ventures at large.

CYBERSECURITY

The Cybersecurity Center (CSC) is a pioneer in cybersecurity education. In 2014, CSUSB received our designation as a CAE in Cyber Defense Education (CDE) through 2021, recognized for our specialty areas in Cyber Investigations and Network Security Administration. The Cybersecurity Program at the Palm Desert Campus provides students with unique learning environments that help accelerate their growth inside and outside of the classroom. From stripping a car to create a vehicle-to-vehicle test bench to providing resources for student projects run through CISO, the student experience at CSUSB is like no other in the Nation.

KINESIOLOGY

Exercise Science Our Kinesiology-Exercise Science is one of the most popular programs among the 23 CSU's in the state of California. The Kinesiology-Exercise Science allows students to obtain careers in exercise testing, fitness and wellness, self coaching, among many more.
