New Point-of-Sale System

University Enterprises Corporation (UEC) is currently working with our dining services provider on the implementation of a new point-of-sale (POS) system. This technology will allow our campus community to seamlessly utilize their on-campus dining plan dollars at our various campus dining venues. The expectation is that this benefit will help generate additional dining revenues, a portion of which will be returned to UEC, which can then be reinvested into campus programs.

The first phase of the POS project has been implemented and we are currently working on implementing the second phase of the project. The goal is to complete the implementation of the new POS system by mid-spring. Another component to the POS system is the availability of a meal exchange program. This will allow meal plan holders to utilize a limited number of their meal plan swipes at several of our dining units. The goal is to have that option available to our campus by mid-April.

Student Center Planned for the Palm Desert Campus



Planning, Design, and Construction is nearing the completion of the design phase of the Palm Desert Campus Student Center. This project, which was funded by the California legislature, will be the first new building on the campus in sixteen years. The 40,025-square-foot, two-story building will be the new home to the campus bookstore, dining facility, event space, expanded library, Associated Students, Rancho Mirage Student Center, Student



more. In addition to the new building, approximately 10,000 square feet of space will be re-purposed in the existing buildings to provide additional faculty offices and academic program support for the expansion of new programs at the Palm Desert Campus. Construction for the new building is on track to begin in Summer 2025 and be completed in Fall 2027. The campus has partnered with LPA Design Studios, an Irvine-based Architectural firm, and C.W.Driver Companies, the Construction Manager.
