Our team will work closely with you and make suggestions to maximize your department budget resources. We are here to serve you!




THE COMMON HUMAN RESOURCES SYSTEM (CHRS) IS LAUNCHING SOON!

CHRS is a systemwide initiative consolidating HR systems and data across all CSU campuses and the Chancellor's Office. This single platform will introduce new features and enhancements for our campus. For the past two years, Human Resources, Faculty Affairs, and ITS teams have worked diligently to configure, test, and prepare CHRS for launch. Final validations and data conversion are now underway.

NEW WIND ADVISORY DASHBOARD TO KEEP CAMPUS INFORMED

CSUSB is introducing a new tool to ensure the campus community is better informed about disruptions caused by high wind events. The **Wind Advisory Dashboard**, now available on the **Facilities Planning and Management disruptions page** (<https://www.csusb.edu/facilities-planning-management/campus-disruptions>), provides real-time updates on any changes to building operations during periods of high winds.

This dashboard is designed to keep students, faculty, and staff up-to-date on closures, access restrictions, and other operational adjustments, helping everyone navigate the challenges that high winds may pose to campus activities. With the dashboard's user-friendly interface, it's now easier than ever to stay informed and plan accordingly during wind events that may affect daily operations.
