Program Details

Students may take two courses per session and finish in 5 months. Courses may also be spread out for those working full time. Eight, 3-unit courses (semester) make up the certificate. The cost is \$450/ unit* Up to 2 qualifying college accounting classes may be transferred in. Introductory classes start in Fall and Spring semesters. See website for schedule.

Admission Requirement

Minimum high school diploma is required. If you have taken college courses or have a degree, transcripts are required.

Certificate of Completion

Upon successfully finishing coursework, you will earn a Certificate of Completion from CSUSB. The certificate courses also satisfy the required education component for the California CPA exam as well as the prerequisites needed to qualify, along with a Bachelor's degree, for the MS in Accountancy program.
