ADAPTED PHYSICAL EDUCATION CREDENTIAL ADDED AUTHORIZATION

Credential Requirements (20 units)

Students who wish to pursue an Adapted Physical Education Added Authorization must meet program admission criteria. In addition to meeting the general requirements of the university for admission as a post-baccalaureate student, admission to the Added Authorization in Adapted Physical Education program requires a valid California teaching credential authorizing the teaching of physical education. The admission procedures are designed to identify students who are committed to the discipline and profession, and to maximize their opportunities to become competent and effective adapted physical education teachers.

All candidates are encouraged to meet with their program advisor to develop their course plan. The following EXAMPLE course sequence is effective Fall 2013, and is subject to change at any time.
