Conducting interviews with students in preparation for professional school interviews in various health fields.



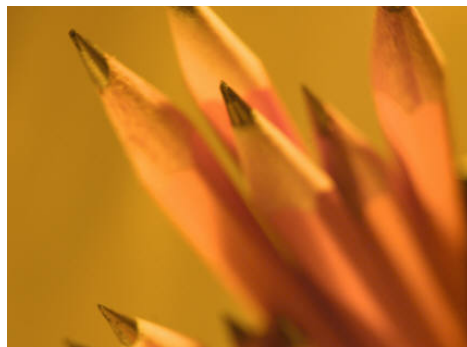
### SUMMER PROGRAMS

Assisting students in finding and obtaining summer research and program positions. Administer UCR Future Physician Leadership program at CSUSB.



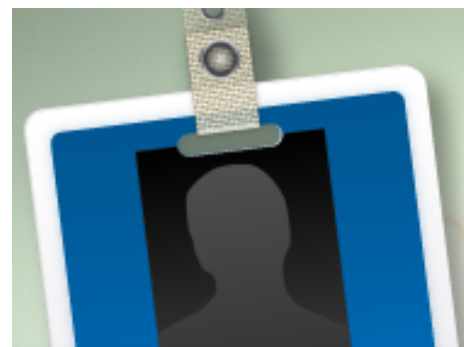
### GRADUATE SCHOOL

### 91% Acceptance Rate

HPAC continued to see CSUSB students succeed and achieve their dreams. Those served by HPAC were accepted to some of the top schools in the country including impressive Ivy League and research institutions. These logos represent the schools students were accepted to in the 2015-2016 application cycle.

This cycle 64 CSUSB students & Alumni applied of those 58 were accepted into summer research programs, post-baccalaureate education or graduate and professional school. This calculates to 91% of those that applied being accepted.





## NEW HPAC INITIATIVES
