# **Bachelor of Arts in Music Roadmaps for Transfers**

**Prior coursework**: These roadmaps assume that a student has completed an Associate Degree for Transfer in Music and has eared transfer credit for all lower-division General Education requirements at CSUSB. The BA in Music degree is specifically designed for completion within two years by a student with an Associate Degree for Transfer in Music from a California community college. "GE" = general education course. However, that design only applies to the "generic" roadmap below. Students who wish to pursue additional curriculums, such as a minor, may not be able to complete their degrees in two years.

Electives: The roadmaps assume transfer students will transfer <u>no</u> elective units in music from prior college coursework. A total of 12 electives must be in upper-division courses (300 level and above). Students should select electives in consultation with a music advisor and may, with the prior approval of that advisor, use courses from non-music disciplines to complete elective requirements. Students should also consider making the most of their electives by pursuing courses that complete a minor, whether the minor is in music or another field. Students who want to pursue a minor in music -- Music Technology, Commercial Music, or Jazz Studies -- or the Music Teacher Preparation Program will find below suggested adjustments and additions to the "generic" roadmap.
