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ORIENTATION LEADER EXPECTATIONS

It is our goal to make the transition to CSUSB as smooth and supportive as possible for our incoming first-year and transfer students. Orientation Leaders play a critical role in fulfilling this goal before, during, and after students arrive on campus and for their first semester.

The following expectations have been established to ensure the best possible experience for new transfer students, the OFYE staff, and fellow Orientation Leaders. Orientation Leaders are expected to:

- actively participate in all aspects of orientation with a positive and professional attitude.
- seek to make first-year and transfer students feel welcomed to CSUSB.
- make every effort to present CSUSB in the best light possible.
- **be early** or on time to all trainings and Orientation-related events.
- dress appropriately and follow orientation staff dress code as established.
- abide by all University policies and standards of student conduct.
- actively promote all campus activities and organizations with which students should be familiar or in which they express interest.
- consistently and reliably act with integrity.
- show that Coyote pride in your campus, your experience, and your time as a CSUSB student.

ORIENTATION LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES

Required responsibilities of Orientation Leaders include:

- Attending all mandatory dates as outlined on the following page.
- Contributing to the logistical set up and tear down of Orientation related events.
- **Guiding** new students through Orientation programs.
- Leading student groups through campus tours, presentations and topics, academic advisement information and campus resources.
- Sharing your personal transition experience and using this to encourage and empower new students.
- Engaging in social connections to build relationships and to help facilitate connections amongst new students.
- Contributing to Orientation, First Year Experience, and Transfer Student Success initiatives by sharing on social media, serving on panels, or communicating with new students.
- Checking in with new students at least once during the fall semester.





Serving as an Orientation Leader is both a unique and rewarding opportunity for personal leadership development and professional growth. This position requires motivated student leaders who have a strong interest in supporting new students with their transition to CSUSB.

All applicants should:

- Demonstrate strong work ethic and initiative.
- Have pride in being a CSUSB student and be eager to share their experience.
- Desire to be a role model on campus and in the community before and after Orientation.
- Have high standards of ethical behavior and professionalism.
- Have a positive attitude.
- · Work well under pressure.
- Be creative, flexible, and have a sense of humor.
- Exhibit a strong commitment to becoming informed and knowledgeable about the university's academic policies, procedures, deadlines, and various advising resources & tools.
- Demonstrate the ability to work with a diverse group of people, including students, families, faculty and staff.

All applicants must:

- be an undergraduate, degreeseeking student.
- be a returning student in Fall 2022.
- have completed at least 12 units at CSUSB by May 2022.
- maintain satisfactory academic progress towards degree completion.
- not be on academic or disciplinary probation with the offices of Student Conduct and Ethical Development or Advising and Academic Services.
- have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and maintain such GPA through terms of position.
- successfully pass a background check per CSU Volunteer policy and procedures.

By applying to the role of Orientation Leader, you consent to Orientation and First Year Experience staff to run certain academic and conduct checks with appropriate offices.
