Interviewing 101

QUICK TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL INTERVIEW

Interviews are beneficial to both applicants and employers as this is the time where you both have the opportunity to exchange information for a potential professional relationship. Take a look at the general and virtual interview tips below to better prepare yourself for your next interview!

General Interview Tips:

- Research the organization
- Have thoughtful questions prepared to ask at the end of the interview
- Practice talking about your knowledge, skills, and abilities
- Send a 'Thank you for the interview' email afterwards

Virtual Interview Tips:

- Test your internet connection and make sure you have a strong WiFi signal
- Make sure you are in a quiet, well-lit space and ensure you have no interruptions
- Your background should be clutter free
