

CSUSB HAS BEEN DESIGNATED AS AN **R2 UNIVERSITY** IN RECOGNITION OF ITS DEVELOPMENT FROM A MASTER'S LEVEL COMPREHENSIVE UNIVERSITY TO ONE THAT AWARDS DOCTORATES.

Cal State San Bernardino recently advanced to the category of Doctoral University: High Research Activity (R2), raising the university's status to a "national university" from a "regional university" by the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education.

CSUSB met the new classification criteria by awarding 21 doctoral degrees and having over \$10.8 million in research expenditures in fiscal year 2019-20.

The new designation also elevates CSUSB's status to a "national university" from a "regional university" in rankings such as U.S. News & World Report.



CSUSB RANKED **TOP TEN** IN THE NATION FOR **SOCIAL MOBILITY**

Out of nearly 1,500 universities in the nation, Cal State San Bernardino was ranked No. 6 on the eighth annual 2021 Social Mobility Index (SMI) published by CollegeNET.

According to CollegeNET's SMI website, SMI measures the extent to which a four-year college or university educates more economically disadvantaged students (with family incomes below the national median) at lower tuition and graduates them into good paying jobs.

According to CollegeNET's website, "A high SMI ranking means that a college is contributing in a responsible way to solving the dangerous problem of declining economic mobility in our country."

CSUSB RECEIVES NATIONAL CYBERSECURITY DESIGNATION FROM NSA

The prestigious designation as the **Community National Center for Cybersecurity Education** illustrates CSUSB's continued prominence as the premier institution of higher education for cybersecurity education.

The CSUSB Cybersecurity Center has attained a high standard of excellence, leveraging its great strengths and successfully receiving a host of impressive grants for the cybersecurity program.

From 2010-2020, the center brought in over \$17.5 million worth of grant-sponsored programs from entities like the National Security Agency (NSA), National Initiative for Cybersecurity Education (NICE), National Cybersecurity Training and Education (NCYTE) Center, and the National Science Foundation (NSF). Through the grant-sponsored activities of the center, students can compete for scholarships, participate in national conferences, and research emerging cybersecurity issues.
