Revenue Challenges

- ✓ CSUSB received a General fund augmentation of \$8.3 million, mostly to cover mandatory cost increases
- ✓ FY 23/24 FTES remains below the Chancellor's Office target




CSUSB GF Appropriation and Tuition Fee Trend FY 14/15 – FY 23/24

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CSUSB GF Appropriation and Tuition Fee Revenue Funding Split Trend – Cont.



FISCAL YEAR 23-24 ENACTED BUDGET

- ✓ The fiscal year 2023-24 budget was enacted on June 27, 2023
- ✓ Consistent with Governor's January proposal and the May Revision, CSU received a 5% increase of \$227.3 million despite a \$31.5 billion projected state deficit
- √ \$25.5 million one-time investments for various purposes, including
 - \$1 million to expand and improve Title IX services and programming, systemwide

FISCAL YEAR 23-24 ENACTED BUDGET

Base Budget CSUSB Impact

- √ \$8,274,000 million base budget increase (from \$227.3M)
 - √ \$5,291,000 million Mandatory Cost increases for Health, Retirement, and Property & Liability Insurance.
 - ✓ \$1,704,000 million for Graduation Initiative 2025

 One-time allocation in FY 22-23
 - √ \$479,000 for Basic Needs

 One-time allocation in FY 22-23
 - √ \$800,000 for State University Grant


