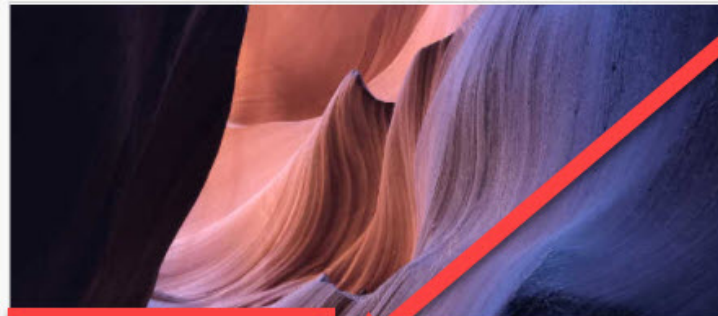

- Migrations performed by K16's Scaffold service; completion may take a few weeks
- Courses migrated from Bb to Canvas will have course ID "bb-2[TERM][DEPT][###][SECTION]"
- E.g., bb-2172HUM18001



Canvas Transition

Migrating content from Blackboard to Canvas

- You will need to copy content from the Canvas migrated content site to the actual course site
- E.g., from bb-2172HUM18001 to COMM 1020
