Since last year's reviews, which noted:

EPRC recommends that the Center for Health Equity be kept on active status. The Committee recognizes the Center's work in establishing their advisory board and engaging in additional activities, including internships for students and submission of a grant proposal. EPRC recommends that the Center submit their next Ancillary Unit Annual Report in Fall 2023 reporting on their activities, funding that the Center has received, and how that funding has been used to further the Center's purpose and goals. EPRC encourages the Center for Health Equity to continue to seek external funding to support their activities.

CHE faculty research teams published 7 peer-reviewed publications.

11 CSUSB students (undergradute and graduate) completed their internship at CHE.

In collaboration with UCR, CHE hosted its annual Future Physician Leaders and Health Coach Programs to recruit CSUSB students for paid internships. Implemented Health Equity speaker series with invited guests.

Three external grants were submitted (two currently under review, one funding was received for \$36,750).
