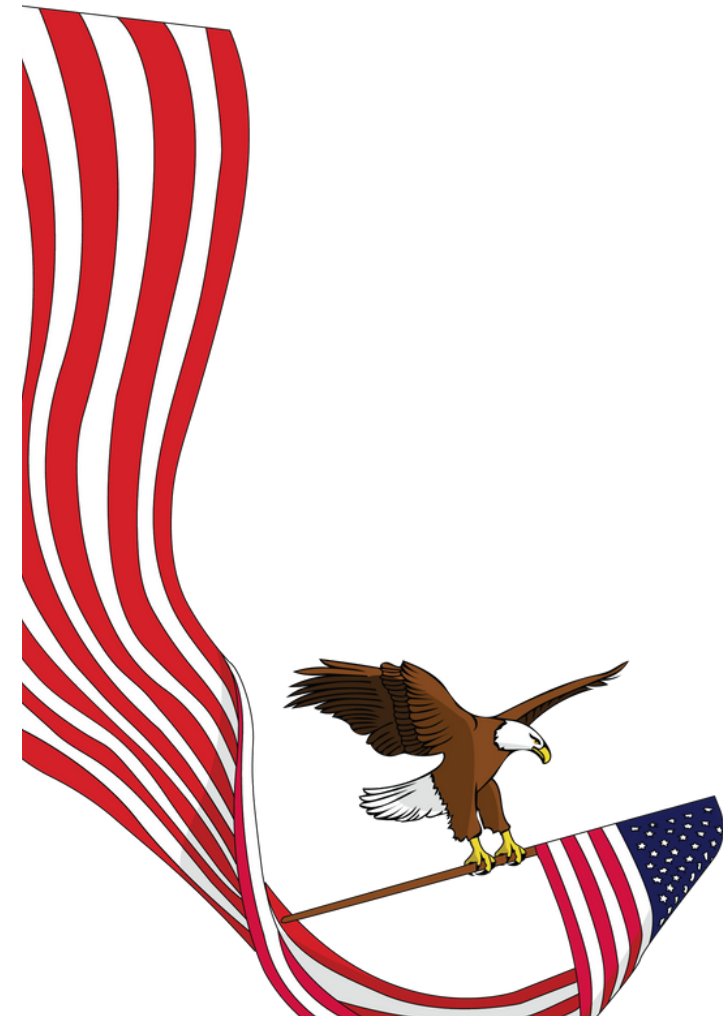

First time using benefits?

- 1.) Apply for CSUSB through CSU Apply and Educational Benefit through VA.gov. Email jespinoza@csusb.edu. Include your CSUSB ID Number and your VR&E Counselor's Name and Email Address
- 2.) Pay confirmation deposit. Email vsc@csusb.edu to waive this fee.
- 3.) Attend SOAR and register for degree applicable courses.
- 4.) Certify your enrollment at CSUSB using MyCoyote Portal
- 5.) File certification with VA at beginning of the term. No tuition or fees will be reported. CSUSB will place deferment on your account, you will not be dropped due to non-payment.
- 7.) Second cert. will be sent to the VA after census date. Tuition and fees will be reported and any other changes in your enrollment. Any courses not selected for certification will not be certified.
- 8.) Stay up to date with MyCoyote to manage any holds and your benefits!

Continuing student using benefits:

- 1.) PO authorization via MyCoyote to check PO expiration and to ensure two PO's listed
 - 2.) Check for any holds from CSUSB on MyCoyote
 - 3.) Check your registration date and prepare your courses using your student portal
 - 4.) Request certification using your CSUSB MyCoyote student portal
 - 5.) Textbooks - School Certifying Official will send student memorandum via email stating PO number for bookstore
- Parking Pass - Financial Services Office will charge student account for parking pass once first request for certification is processed
