



Composition and Technology Area Audition Requirements

Bachelor of Arts

Prospective BA music students interested in studying applied composition and/or technology should be able to demonstrate a level of proficiency on a primary instrument/voice similar to that of a BA applicant in those areas. If this proficiency is not met, an incoming BA music student may be asked to take up to one year of applied lessons on a primary instrument/voice before starting applied composition lessons, or up to two years before starting applied technology lessons.

1. An audition on a primary instrument or voice (following the BA audition requirements for that area)
2. A portfolio of two creative projects, documented as either scores (PDFs), recordings (MP3, AIF, WAV, or MIDI files), screenshots of electronic-music projects, and/or videos.
