EOP STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The primary objective of the Educational Opportunity Program (EOP) at California State University, San Bernardino, is to support you throughout your college journey by assisting you in meeting your academic, career and personal goals. Now that you have been admitted into EOP we will partner with you in reaching your goals and you are expected to adhere to the following responsibilities:

- 1. Attend a minimum of three appointments per semester with your EOP counselor
 - a. Attend academic advisement sessions
 - b. Attend progress report sessions
 - c. Attend EOP co-curricular programming (i.e. workshops and activities)
- 2. Attend and participate in all classes on a regular basis
- 3. Adhere to all pertinent EOP and university policies and regulations
- 4. Enroll in at least 12 to 15 units each semester
- 5. Maintain a minimum of a 2.0 or above CSUSB and cumulative grade-point-average
- 6. Attend the fall and spring mandatory Mid-Semester meetings
- 7. Attend tutoring sessions and supplemental instruction courses, if recommended, unless exempted by your EOP counselor
- 8. Check your CSUSB email on a daily basis
- 9. Check your MyCoyote account on a weekly basis for holds and To-Do items
- 10. Notify your EOP Counselor of any major factors that may affect your student status, for example:
 - a. Change in class schedule or unit load
 - b. Change of address or phone number
 - c. Extended consecutive absences or withdrawal from university

If the above listed responsibilities are not fulfilled, you may be subject to academic probation or dismissal from EOP and the University.
