MINOR PROGRAM IN EDUCATION

Requirements (24 units)

BRIEF DESCRIPTION: Students can begin the minor in Fall, Winter, or Spring. Six courses (from a possible seven) are required to complete the minor. Students can complete the minor in a minimum of two quarters or take six quarters if they take one course at a time.

All candidates are encouraged to meet with their program advisor to develop their course plan. The following EXAMPLE course sequences are effective Fall 2013, and is subject to change at any time.
