The California Pre-Doctoral Program (Pre-Doc)

Benefits

- Travel Funds
- Professional Development Funds
- A Summer Research Experience

Eligibility

- Upper-division or master's degree students enrolled at a CSU
- Applicants must have a faculty mentor





Chancellor's Doctoral Incentive Program (CDIP)

Benefits

- Loans of up to \$10,000 per year over five years, up to a maximum amount of \$30,000
- Full-time & Part-time teaching in the CSU are considered for loan forgiveness
- Professional development workshops
- Networking
- Grant and research support

Eligibility

- Undergraduate and master's level students who are, or will be enrolled full-time in a doctoral program at an accredited university within the US
- Full or part-time lecturers
- Must be eligible to work in the United States

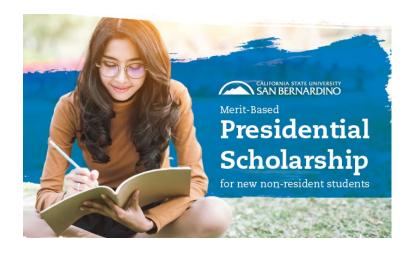




The Merit-Based Presidential Scholarship

Details

- For new non-resident students
- Graduate Student Award Amount -\$4,000/year
- Two years maximum award duration



Eligibility

- Must be admitted to CSUSB
- Must be a degree-seeking, non-resident student
- Must be enrolled in no fewer than 9 units per term
- Must have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.5 in the last 60 semester/90 quarter units attempted.

- Free and easy to apply
- If you don't fill it out, you may miss out
 - Apply early
 - Apply yearly
- Federal Work Study

State University Grant (SUG)

- The maximum annual SUG award is up to the tuition/fee
- Does not cover additional campus charges
- Limited funding and based on availability of funding at time of review
- May not receive a SUG if you are receiving another type of aid that pays your tuition fee costs.



Over 60 Program

Allows a limited number of California residents, sixty years of age or older to enroll in regular session courses without payment of certain specified fees.

- Open to California residents, 60years of age or older
- All regular admission requirements must be met

- Excludes books, parking, and lab/supply fees
- Office of the Registrar Over 60Program
