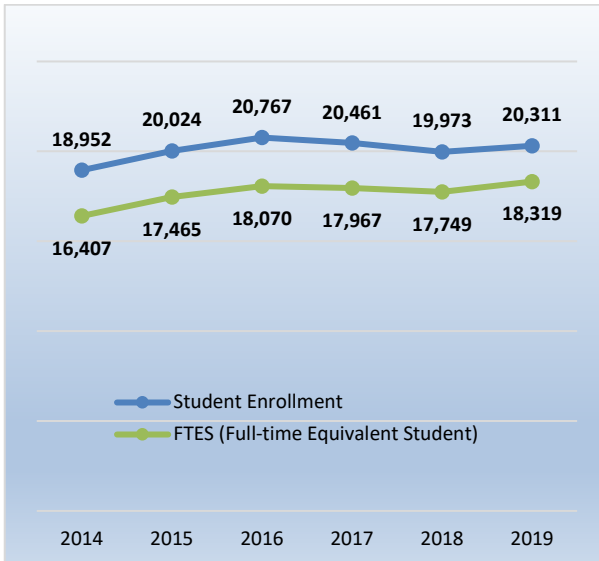

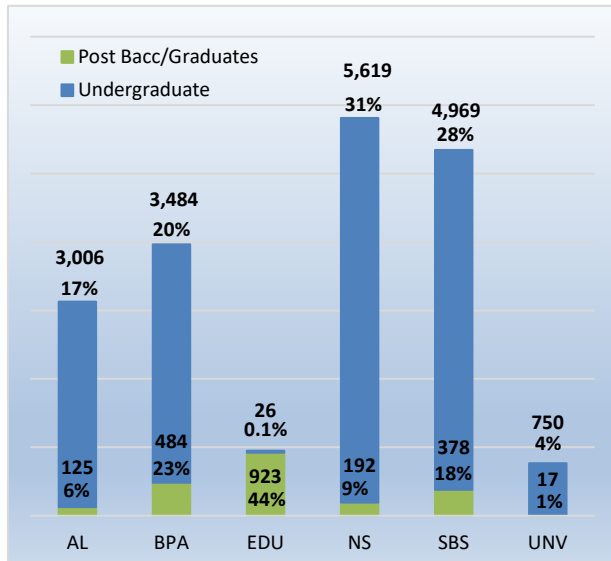

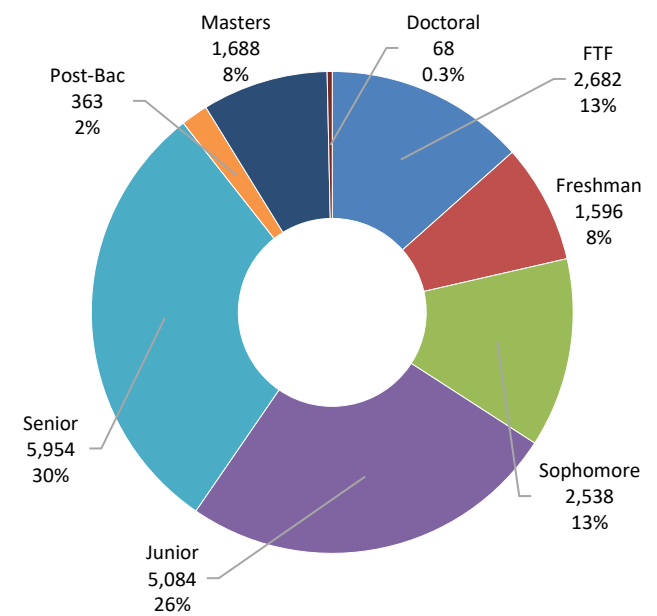
Student Enrollment & FTES Fall 2014-2019



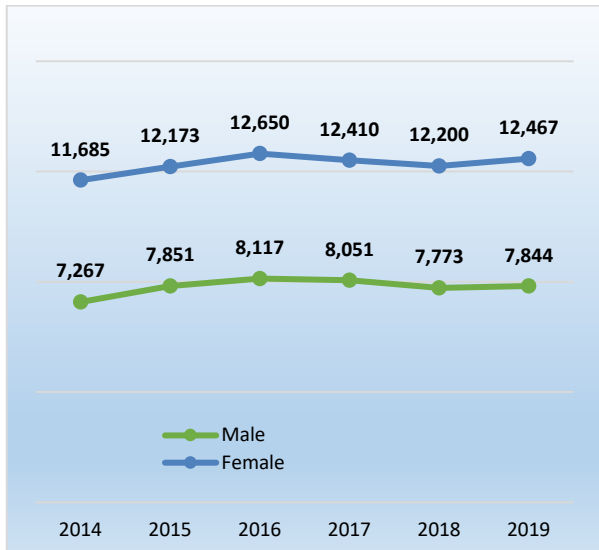
Student Enrollment by College of Major Fall 2019



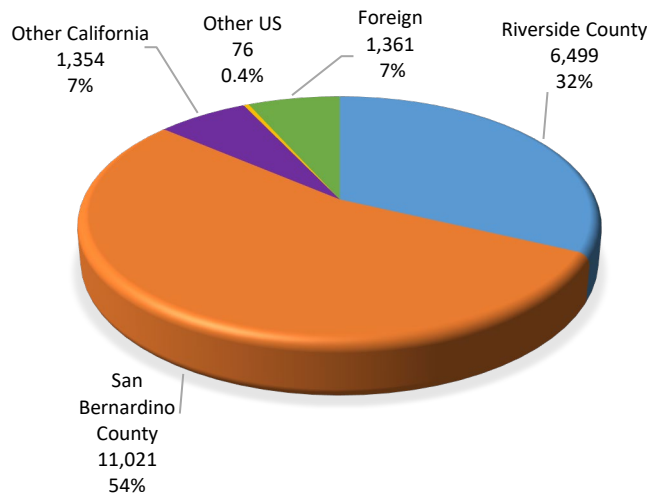
Student Enrollment by Level Fall 2019



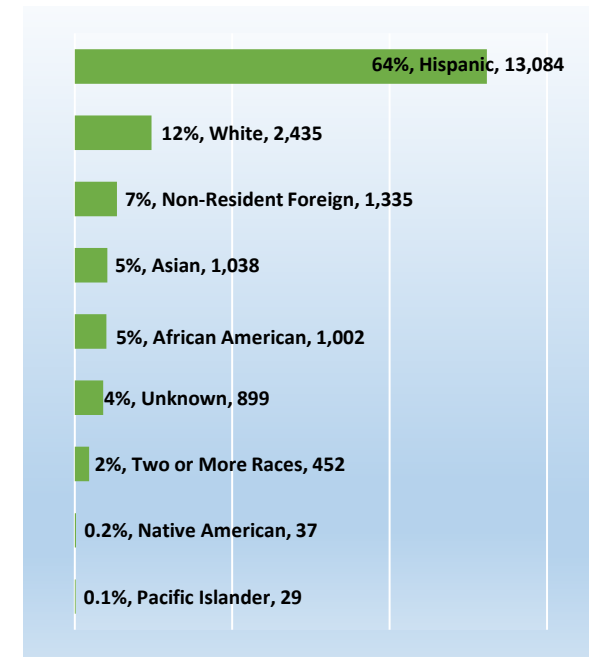
Student Enrollment by Gender Fall 2014-2019
