The program is funded by CSUSB's Research, Scholarly, and Creative Activity Committee through Academic Affairs. The goal is to strengthen the campus internationalization by facilitating faculty travel that supports international research, publications, conference presentations, and grant writing. In addition, developing opportunities to expand study abroad for CSUSB students, encouraging the development of professor's foreign language skills related to their professional goals, and strengthening relationships with partner institutions outside of the U.S.

PAB Program

The program awards grants in the amount of \$500 to \$2,500 based on the quality of the proposals and their potential for contributing to the campus' internationalization process. Grant recipients will be notified in April if their proposal was accepted. The PAB program, coordinated by the Center for International Studies and Programs, is funded through the Research, Scholarly, and Creative Activity Committee. Proposals will be evaluated by the PAB Exective Committee.

Deadline: February 1, 2023

Application Eligibility:

- All Unit 3 employees are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must demonstrate how they will meet funding objectives.
