GE Advising for Semesters

GE-E (Lifelong Understanding) (3 semester unit)

E comes first (A2 and B4) – We highly encourage students to take this first year seminar in the first two terms.

Beginning Fall 2020 E category is one class. E classes from community college will transfer to CSUSB regardless of seminar format.

*E seminars are NOT major specific. They are designed for non-majors.

GE-A (Basic Skills)- No Change A1-Oral Communication; A2 – Written Communication; A3 Critical Thinking

GE-B (Natural Sciences)

GE-B1 (Physical Sciences); GE-B2 (Life Sciences); GE-B3 (Lab);

GE-B4 = Mathematics/Quantitative Reasoning; GE B5 – Upper Division Scientific Inquiry

Labs are separate from lectures (B3) in most, but not all cases. Students only need to have 1 lab-course for GE. Some labs pair with lectures others are stand alone.

GE-C (Humanities)

GE-C1 (Arts) - Required. No Change

GE-C2 (Humanities)

GE- C3 - choice of another C1 or C2

GE - C4 - Upper Division Arts & Humanities

GE-D (Social and Behavioral Sciences)

GE-D1 (American Government); GE-D2 (US History) – Both required. No Change (letters reversed to match state) **GE-D3 (Social Science Discipline Perspectives); D4 Upper Division**

Writing Intensive Program (no more 306)

2 WI courses required – usually 1 in GE and one in major – at least one must be upper division The majority of GE WI classes are in C4, some in C2, very few in D Most majors include a WI - **careful advising required for majors choosing to not include a WI

DI and G Designated Courses – Course Overlays found throughout the curriculum
