- Track B plus passing the CBEST and CSET exams will allow students to pursue a single-subject credential. To teach at a community college, a MA degree is the minimum requirement.
- a 24-unit concentration is required. PDC offers the concentration in **United States History**.

Outside Concentration Area (OCA)

- In addition to the 24-unit concentration, you will need to complete 4 units in *each* area outside the United States History concentration:
 - African History
 - Asian History/Middle East
 - European History
 - Latin American History
- HIST 494 and HIST 594 must be completed at the San Bernardino Campus (SBC).
