b. Fill out your timesheet form, date it, sign it by typing "/s/" and then your name in the signature block (for example "/s/ Lark Winner" would appear in typeface in the signature block), and convert to PDF or scan the document and email it to the designated individual to whom you normally submit your timesheet.

Again, if you have not already submitted your timesheet, please defer to using one of the options listed above instead of submitting your timesheet in hard copy form, as we want you to remain safe and comply with the statewide restrictions that have limited access to campus to stop the spread of COVID-19.

For those of you who have a Spring 2020 appointment, as stated in the email we sent yesterday evening, beginning the Spring 2020 quarter, all timesheets for Unit 11 employees will be submitted electronically via Adobe Sign. Dates and times for online training courses on this new process will be available during the week of March 30, 2020, and a pre-recorded online training course may also be available. We anticipate that we will be able to send you a list and/or link for the training courses for the Adobe Sign training and process for Unit 11 employees by the close of business this Friday, March 27, 2020.
