FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM CSUSB INTERNAL GRANTS

SERVICE LEARNING FELLOWSHIP

The Fellowship program is designed to support faculty in developing service learning opportunities for CSUSB students. Service Learning Fellows can use these funds to infuse service learning into an existing course or to develop a new course with a strong service learning component.

Award: up to \$2000 (Professional Development Funds) Application Deadline: 9/16/22; 10/7/22; 11/18/22; 12/2/22

ESTABLISHING COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

This grant program offers faculty substantial support in their efforts to establish or further develop community partnerships as a first step to other community engagement strategies, including but not limited to community-based learning and service learning both in formal classes and in other teachingrelated activities, as well as in community-based and community participatory research, scholarly, and creative activities.

Award: up to \$3000 (Professional Development Funds) Application Deadline: 9/16/22; 10/7/22; 11/18/22; 12/2/22

COMMUNITY-BASED RESEARCH MINI-GRANTS

This program offers faculty a mini-grant to support community-based research (CBR) projects. CBR is a partnership between University researchers and community partners who collaboratively engage in research with the purpose of solving a pressing community-identified issue and/or effect social change.

Award: up to \$5000 (Professional Development Funds)
Application Deadline: 9/16/22; 10/7/22; 11/18/22; 12/2/22

PROFESSORS ACROSS BORDERS

The PAB program contributes to campus internationalization by facilitating faculty engagement in international research, conference presentations and publications, grant writing, and curriculum internationalization.

Award: up to \$2500 (Professional Development Funds)
Application Deadline: 2/1/23

CERTIFICATE PROGRAM IN TEACHING/LEARNING, COMMUNITY SERVICE, AND RESEARCH

The program encourages faculty to choose from development options from among numerous options in Academic Affairs programs: teaching, research (faculty research fellow), new faculty mentoring, community service, academic research, and others. While all seminars are open to all faculty, this year's faculty development certificate requires: (1) attendance at 12 sessions from a list of those approved on the FDP website; (2) an informal, 750 word essay about how some or all of the programming affected your teaching, research, and/or community service practices; (3) completion of the Certificate Program's Survey; and (4) participation in the spring certificate ceremony.

Award: \$1500 (Professional Development Funds)
Application Deadline: 4/15/23

TRAVEL SKILLS STUDY AWARDS (TSSA)

The purpose of the TSSA program is to enhance faculty's TEACHING by attending a conference devoted to university teaching or to a high-impact, evidence or a newly developing teaching practice

INNOVATIVE COURSE DEVELOPMENT GRANTS

The purpose of the TRC Course Development grants is to support faculty to redesign or develop a course in ways that implement high-impact, evidence-based, and/or innovative teaching strategies to improve student learning. Such redesign and/or development must go significantly above and beyond regular course preparation and clearly relate to improving student learning and engagement. Support from this grant program does not include support for course revision or course development that is part of faculty's regular teaching assignment.

OFFICE OF STUDENT RESEARCH

FACULTY/STUDENT GRANTS

The Faculty/Student Grants offered by the Office of Student Research (OSR) are designed to facilitate the initiation and development of collaborative research or creative activity (RCA) between students and faculty. The maximum amount of \$1,500 may be awarded to each faculty/student team. The number of grants awarded depends on budgets and the funds available to the Office of Student Research each year. Projects under this program are intended to provide students indepth "hands-on" experience in the research or creative activity process.

Award: \$1500 one-time payment (Research/Grant Funds) Application Deadline: 9/25/22;

RESEARCH AND CREATIVE ACTIVITIES FACULTY MENTOR AWARD

In recognition of our faculty, the OSR has created the Faculty Research and Creative Activities (RCA) Mentor Award. Contingent on the availability of funding, the award will annually recognize the contributions, within the previous two years of up to five faculty (one per college), whose mentoring is considered exemplary. Each Faculty RCA Mentor Award recipient will receive \$2,000. The application review committee will evaluate faculty's contributions to student success and evidence of their mentorship to students in research and creative activities within the previous two academic years.

Award: \$2000 one-time payment (Professional Development Funds)
Application Deadline: 2/26/23

UNDERGRADUATE SUMMER RESEARCH PROGRAM

The Undergraduate Summer Research Program provides funding and resources to support undergraduate students who are interested in pursuing research projects or scholarly activities related to their field over the summer term. Faculty apply for this program with a team of two to three students. The role of the faculty in the summer program is crucial

Award: \$5000 (Research/Stipend)
Application Deadline: 2/26/23
