

Kinesiology Safety Acknowledgement

Before Fall 2023 Registration begins, anyone taking a KINE course needs to complete the Kinesiology Safety Acknowledgement form. Students will not be able to register for classes unless this is complete. This safety acknowledgement will cover Fall 2023, Winter 2024, Spring 2024, and Summer 2024).

2. Select "Create New"
