• Select a track:

-General Track: (Pre-Credential)

This track is especially designed for students wishing to enter elementary school teaching and requires a 16-18 units of a concentration. The following concentrations can be completed at PDC:

-Integrated Track: (B.A. and Multiple Subject Credential)

This track is especially designed for students wishing to enter elementary school teaching *AND* who want to save time by working on credential preparation along with their B.A. degree.
